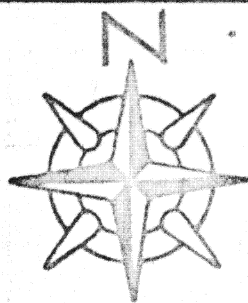


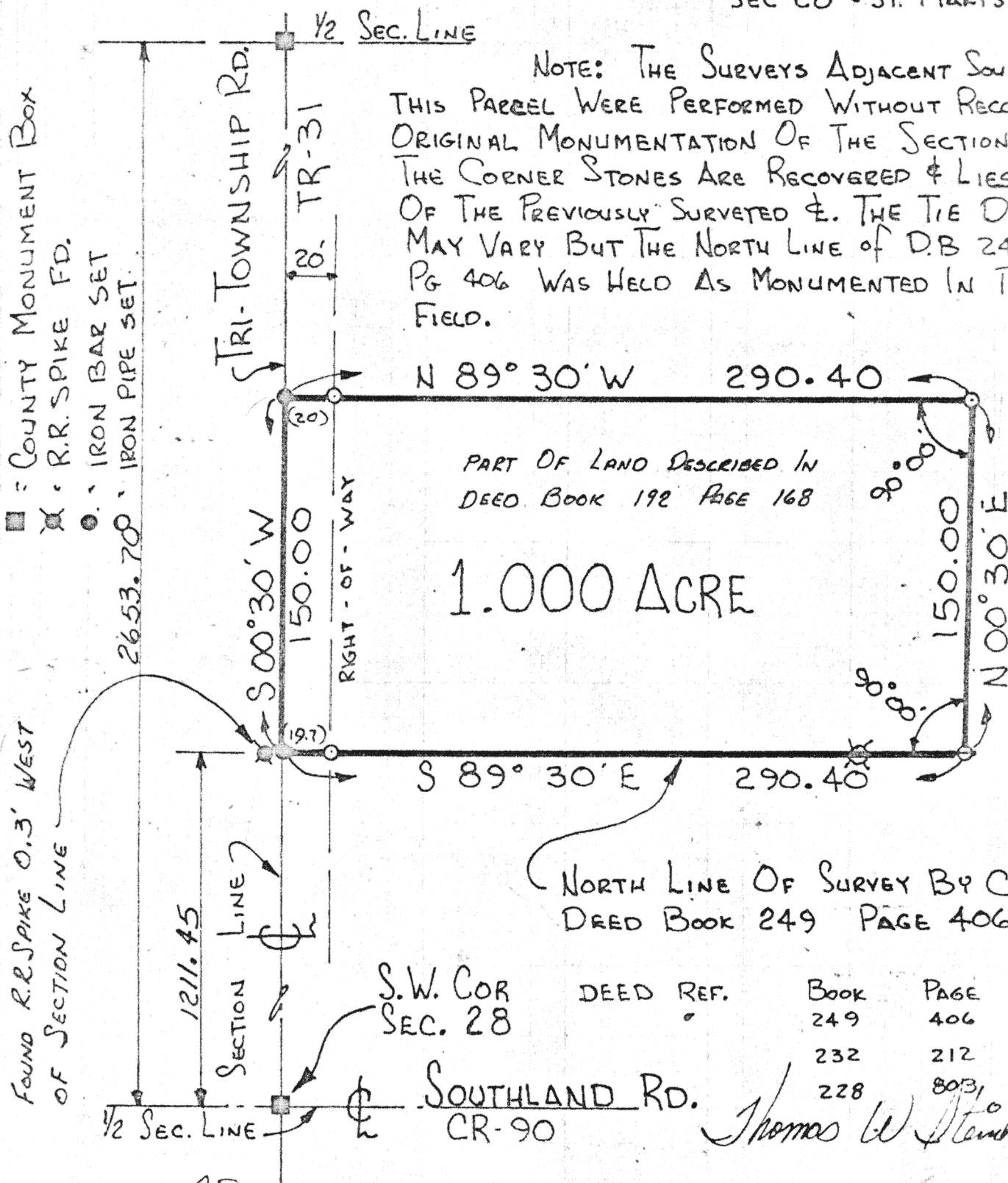

Being 1.000 Acre located in the south-west quarter of Section 28, Town 6-S, Range 4-E, St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box located at the south-west corner of Section 28, said point being the center line intersection of Southland Road (CR 90) and Tri-Township Road (TR 31).

Thence North  $00^{\circ} 30'$  East along the west line of Section 28 and the center line of Tri-Township Road, a distance of 1211.45 feet to an iron bar and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described.

Thence South  $89^{\circ} 30'$  East, a distance of 290.4 feet to an iron pipe, passing through an iron pipe at 19.7 feet.

Thence North  $00^{\circ} 30'$  East, a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence North  $89^{\circ} 30'$  West, a distance of 290.40 feet to an iron bar in the west line of Section 28 and center line of Tri-Township Road, passing through an iron pipe at 270.4 feet.

Thence South  $00^{\circ} 30'$  West along said section line and center line, a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron bar and the PLACE OF BEGINNING.
