

SURVEYORS DESCRIPTION

The following described tract of land is part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 25, fown 5 South, Range 6 East, Duchouquet Townhip, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows.

Commencing at the stone at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 25 Duchouquet Township (Stone being in the center of the Middle Pike #150) Thence South 89 14 East along the center of the Middle Pike #150, 1,06550 feet to a rail-road spike, this being the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Thence continuing South 89 2 14 East along the center of the Middle Pike #150 266.00 feet to a railroad spike.

Thence North 2 23 East (passing through a concrete post set at 24.70 feet) 236.35 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence North 88: 59'West, 267.70 feet to an iron pipe...

Thence South 1 - 58 West, passing through a concrete monument set at 68.18 feet, 237.48 feet to the railroad spike in the center of the Middle Pike #150 which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above described tract of land contains 1.451 acres more or less subject to 0.183 acres dedicated to the public for highway purposes and to all other legal easements of record.
