

Being 1.908 Acres located in the north-east quarter of Section 35. Town 5-S. Range 4-E. Noble Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows.

Commencing at an iron pipe located at the south-west corner of the north-east quarter of Section 35.

Thence east along the east-west half section line of Section 35 and the center line of Shipman Road T-146, a distance of 990.59 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described.

Thence continuing east along said center line and section line, a distance of 339.30 feet to an iron bar.

Thence northward with an interior angle to this parcel of 89 49' 50", a distance of 245.00 feet to an iron bar, passing through an iron corner post at 12.5 feet.

Thence westward with an interior angle to this parcel of 90° 10' 10", along an existing fence line, a distance of 339.30 feet to an iron bar.

Thence southward with an interior angle to this parcel of 89° 49° 50", along an existing fence line, a distance of 245.00 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, making an interior angle with the beginning course of this parcel of 90° 10° 10°.
