

## E. Heffner Survey

Being 5.006 Acres located in the south-west quarter of Section 20, Town 4-South, Range 5-East, Logan Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the north-southhalf Section line of Section 26 and the center line of Kossuth-Amanda Road, said point being marked by a railroad spike and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described.

Thence north on said north-south half section line, a distance of 132.2 feet to an iron pipe, said point being 985.53 feet south of the center of Section 25.

Thence westward with an interior angle to this parcel of 80° 45° 55", a distance of 870.41 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence southward with an interior angle to this parcel of 99° 44° 35", a distance of 375.48 feet to a railroad spike in the center line of Kossuth-Ft. Amanda Road.

Thence in a north-easterly direction along the centerline of Kossuth-Ft. Amanda Road, with an interior angle  $\dagger$ 0 this parcel of  $65^{\circ}$  33° 00", a distance of 943.66 feet to a railroad spike and the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 5.006 Acres and being subject to 0.65 Acre in road right-of-way.
