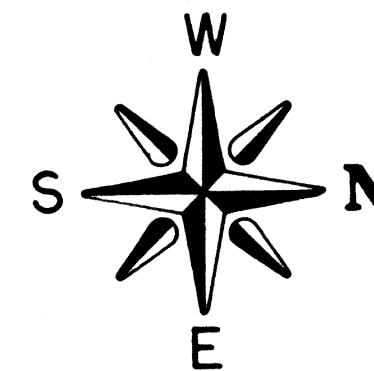


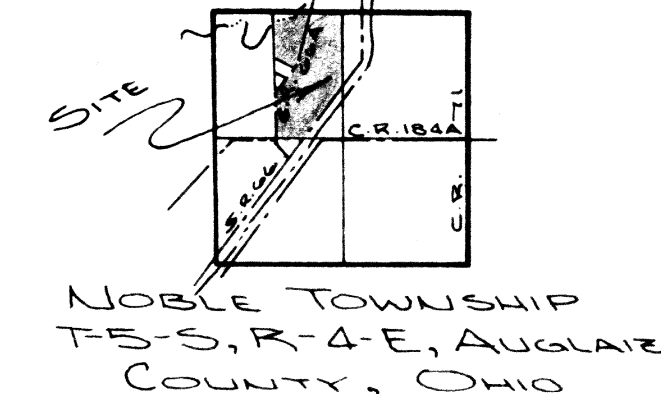

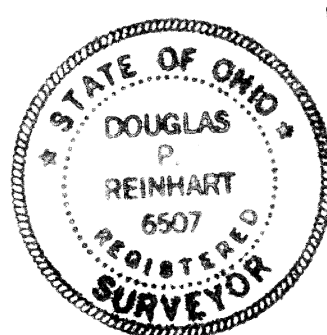

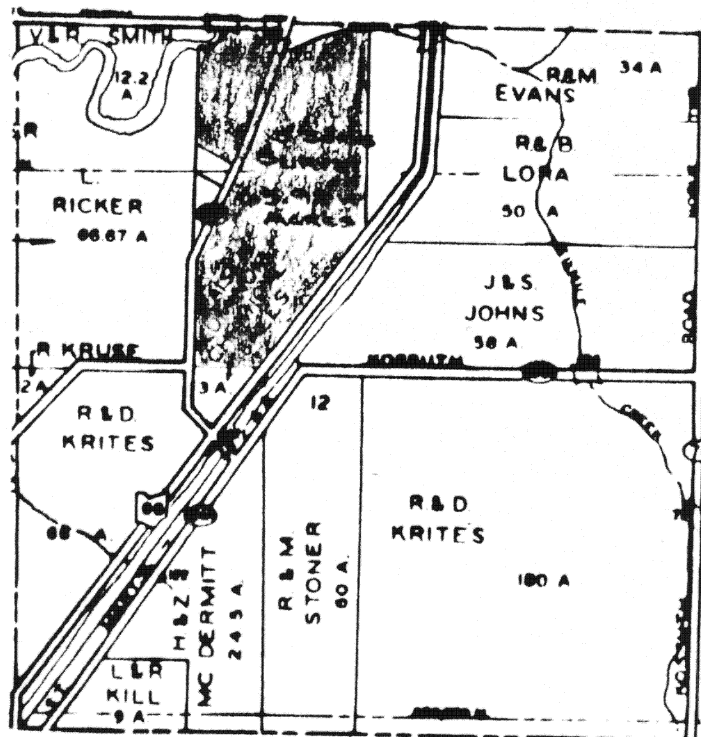

The following described parcel of ground is part of the North half of Section 12, Noble Township, Township Five (5) South, Range Four (4) East, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box at the Northwest corner of Section 12, said box being in the centerline of County Road # 190 (C.R. # 190 known as the Salem Noble Road); Thence with an assumed bearing of N90°-00'E along the North line of Section 12 and the centerline of C.R. # 190 a distance of 1615.20 feet to a point in the center of a bridge over the St. Marys River and the PLACE OF BEGINNING;

Thence continuing N90°-00'E along the North line of Section 12 and the centerline of C.R. # 190 a distance of 524.24 feet to a spike in the centerline of County Road # 66-A;

Thence S19°-29'-45"W along the centerline of C.R. # 66-A a distance of 240.20 feet to a P.K. Nail in a bridge over Six Mile Creek;

Thence N70°-26'-40"E along the centerline of Six Mile a distance of 312.00 feet;

Thence N74°-56'-20"E along the centerline of Six Mile Creek a distance of 207.80 feet;

Thence N88°-14'E along the centerline of Six Mile Creek a distance of 113.49 feet;

Thence S89°-09'E along the centerline of Six Mile Creek a distance of 143.10 feet;

Thence S81°-30'-30"E along the centerline of Six Mile Creek a distance of 152.28 feet;

Thence N81°-07'E along the centerline of Six Mile Creek a distance of 96.47 feet to the West right-of-way line of State Route # 66;

Thence in a southwesterly direction along a curve being the West right-of-way line of State Route # 66, said right-of-way line being 65.00 feet left of the centerline survey of State Route # 66 as completed by the Ohio Department of Transportation with the centerline data for said curve being as follows: $\Delta = 31^{\circ}-28'$ lt.; $D^{\circ}=1^{\circ}-00'$; $R=5729.58'$; $T=1614.11'$; $L=3146.67'$; The chord of said curve along the West right-of-way line from the last described point in the centerline of Six Mile Creek has a bearing of S25°-04'-50"W with a distance of 2493.48 feet to an iron pin in the West right-of-way line of S.R. # 66, 65.00 feet lt. of Station 961+30.69 being the PC of the above described curve;

Thence S38°-51'W along the West right-of-way line of S.R. # 66 a distance of 397.58 feet to an iron pin in the South line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 12;

Thence S89°-45'W along the South line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 12 a distance of 420.36 feet to a spike in the centerline of County Road # 66-A;

Thence N00°-05'-25"E along the quarter-quarter section line a distance of 893.53 feet to an iron pin;

Thence N44°-47'E along the centerline of C.R. # 66-A a distance of 344.32 feet to an iron pipe;

Thence N20°-45'-30"E along the centerline of C.R. # 66-A a distance of 500.99 feet to a railroad spike;

Thence N69°-14'-30"W a distance of 157.07 feet to an iron pin;

Thence N84°-01'W a distance of 136.60 feet to an iron pin;

Thence S72°-56'W a distance of 101.18 feet to an iron pin;

Thence S52°-26'W a distance of 49.85 feet to an iron pin in the North-South Quarter-Quarter section line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 12;

Thence N00°-05'-25"E along said quarter-quarter section line through an iron pin at 772.82 feet for a total distance of 807.82 feet to the centerline of the St. Marys River;

Thence N85°-38'-20"E along the centerline of the St. Marys River a distance of 232.77 feet;

Thence N13°-47'-20"E along the centerline of the St. Marys River a distance of 208.30 feet to a point in the North line of Section 12 and the centerline of C.R. # 190 and the PLACE OF BEGINNING.
