MOORMAN SURVEY DESCRIPTION

September 16, 1982

Being a parcel of land situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 14, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a corner stone at the northwest corner of said Section 14;

Thence, South $2^{\circ} 23' 30''$ West, a distance of one thousand eight hundred twenty and $85/100$ (1820.85) feet to a P.K. nail, on the centerline of Quellhorst Rd., said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument;

Thence, continuing, South $2^{\circ} 23' 30''$ West, along the last described line, a distance of four hundred twenty-eight and $81/100$ (428.81) feet to a point;

Thence, North $88^{\circ} 15' 13''$ East, along the approximate existing centerline of a ditch, a distance of two hundred fifty-five and $16/100$ (255.16) feet to a point;

Thence, North $1^{\circ} 01'$ West, a distance of one hundred eighty-four and $80/100$ (184.80) feet to a $5/8''$ iron bar, said point being the southeast corner of a 0.888 acre parcel as conveyed to Randal P. and Susan K. Moorman by Deed Volume 242, Pg. 316; said line passes thru a $5/8''$ iron bar at sixteen and $00/100$ (16.00) feet;

Thence, South $88^{\circ} 59'$ West, along the south line of said 0.888 acre parcel, a distance of two hundred eight and $23/100$ (208.23) feet to a $5/8''$ iron bar, said point being on the east right-of-way line of State Route 66;

Thence, North $2^{\circ} 17' 30''$ West, along said east right-of-way line of State Route 66, a distance of one hundred one and $06/100$ (101.06) feet to a concrete right-of-way monument;

Thence, North $44^{\circ} 22' 40''$ East, along said east right-of-way line of State Route 66, a distance of one hundred fifty-five and $17/100$ (155.17) feet to a concrete right-of-way monument;

Thence, North $88^{\circ} 59'$ East, along the south right-of-way line of Quellhorst Road, a distance of eighty and $00/100$ (80.00) feet to a concrete right-of-way monument;

Thence, North $1^{\circ} 01'$ West, a distance of thirty and $00/100$ (30.00) feet to a P.K. nail, said point being on the centerline of Quellhorst Rd.;

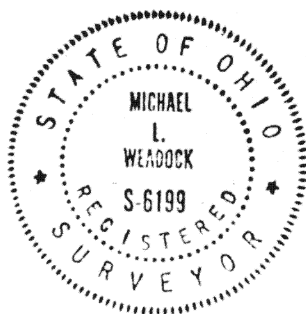
Thence, South $88^{\circ} 59'$ West, along said centerline of Quellhorst Rd., a distance of two hundred nine and $64/100$ (209.64) feet to the place of beginning.

Said parcel contains 1.4846 acres of land more or less of which 0.6027 acres is in road right-of-way.

Subject to an easement for highway purposes from William G. Walter, Vol. 170, Page 659. Also subject to any other easements or rights-of-way of record.

The centerline of Quellhorst Road was assumed to bear South $88^{\circ} 59'$ West, all other bearings were calculated from angles turned.

Reference is made to a boundary survey of this area completed in September, 1982, by Michael L. Weadock, Registered Surveyor #6199, on file in the County Engineer's Office. Reference is also made to a 0.888 acre survey for Don Walter completed in December, 1974, by Thomas W. Steinke, Registered Surveyor #6177, also on file in the County Engineer's Office.
