SURVEYORS DESCRIPTION

The following described tract of land is part of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of Section 25, Town 6 South, Range 7 East, Clay Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and a strip of land on the East side of the Northeast Fractional Quarter of Section 26, Town 6 South, Range 7 East, Clay Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows.
The PLACE OF BEGINNING being the stone at the Northwest corner of section 25, Clay Township (stone being also at the intersection of Road T-241 and State Route #720)

Thence S 89° 46' 11"E along the center of State Route #720, 344.87 feet to a iron pin at the P.I. of a curve to the right.

Thence S 61° 44' 29"E along the center of State Route # 720, 1117.53 feet to a railroad spike on the east line of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Clay Township.

Thence S 00° 12' 10"E along the east line of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Clay Township, 1007.29 feet to a stone on the Indian Treaty Boundary Line.

Thence S 83° 49' 05"W, along the Indian Treaty Boundary Line and passing into section 26 of Clay Township 1476.59 feet to a 1" iron pipe.

Thence N 00° 02' 41"W (passing through a 8" wood post set at 1675.42 feet) 1697.22 feet to a railroad spike in the center of State Route #720.

Thence S 89° 48' 53"E along the center of State Route #720, 136.55 feet to the stone at the Northwest corner of section 25, Clay Township, which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above described tract of land contains 48.430 acres more or less of which 43.133 acres lies in section 25, Clay Township and 5.297 acres lies in section 26, Clay Township and in all subject to 0.918 acres more or less for highway purposes and to all legal easements of record.

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
