The following described tract of land is part of the Northwest Quarter of section 26, Town 6 South, Range 7 East, Clay Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows.

Commencing at the stone at the Northwest corner of section 26, Clay Township (stone being in the center of State Route #720) Thence S 89° 48' 53"E along the center of State Route #720, 1323.26 feet to a railroad spike, this being the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Thence continuing S 89° 48' 53"E along the center of State Route #720, 662.74 feet to a railroad spike.

Thence S 00° 20' 47"E (passing through a 12" wood post set at 24.14 feet) 2618.97 feet to a 12" x 12" wood post, setting on the south line of the North half of section 26, Clay Township.

Thence N 89° 34' 03"W along the south line of the North half of Section 26, Clay Township, 1993.62 feet to a 1" iron pipe set on the west line of section 26, Clay Township.

Thence N 00° 10' 53"W along the west line of section 26 Clay Township, 338.58 feet to a 1" iron pipe set on the Indian Treaty Boundary Line.

Thence N 83° 49' 05"E along the Indian Treaty Boundary Line, 1321.57 feet to a 1" iron pipe on the west line of the east half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 26, Clay Township.

Thence N 00° 03' 31"E, along the west line of the east half of the Northwest quarter of section 26, Clay Township and (passing through a 8" wood post setting at 2103.51 feet) 2125.12 feet to the railroad spike in the center of State Route #720, which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above described tract of land contains 52.879 acres more or less subject to 0.380 acres for highway purposes and to all other legal easements of record.
