Commencing for reference at a railroad spike at the center of said Section 26,

Thence, North, along the west line of the northeast quarter of said Section 26, a distance of five hundred thirty-six and 36/100 (536.36) feet to a 5/8'' iron bar, said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument;

Thence, continuing, North, along the last described line, a distance of eight hundred six and 70/100 (806.70) feet to a 5/8'' iron bar, said line passing thru a stone at five hundred seventy and 19/100 (570.19) feet;

Thence, North 89° 34' 45'' East, along the east-west quarter section line, a distance of two thousand twenty-six and 25/100 (2026.25) feet to a 5/8'' iron bar;

Thence, South 00° 10' 45" West, a distance of eight hundred six and 72/100 (806.72) feet to a 5/8" iron bar;

Thence, South 89° 34' 45'' West, a distance of two thousand twenty-three and 71/100 (2023.71) feet to the place of beginning.

Thence, South 89[°] 30' 30' West, a distance of six hundred twenty-six and 29/100 (626.29) feet to a 5/8" iron bar;


