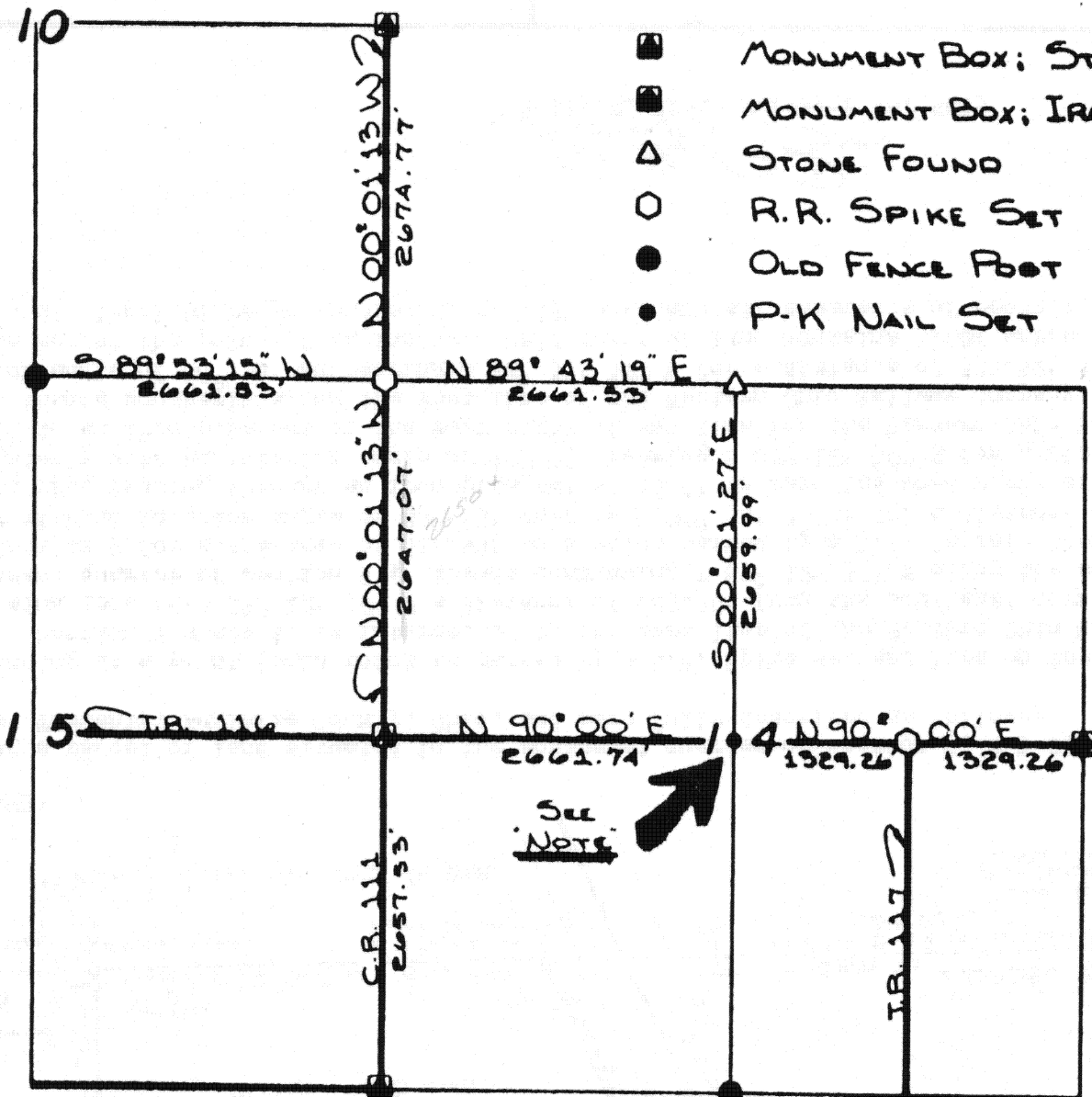
ESTABLISHING THE CENTER AND NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 14:

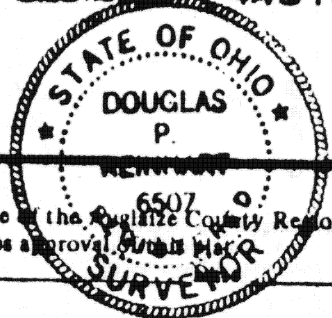
