
Being part of Out Lots # 2 and 5 of the Schroder's Subdivision in the Village of New Bremen, Ohio. Monumentation shown hereon as being found were formerly set by Clayton H. Stimmel or Richard T. Mote or Thomas W. Steinke. County Road # 66-A was determined to be a 50 Ft. R/W as opposed to a 60 Ft. R/W as shown on surveys adjacent north.



Being 0.9649 Acre and being part of Out Lots # 2 and # 5 of the Schroder's Subdivision in the Billage of New Bremen, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at the center line intersection of Herman Street and Pearl Street in the Village of New Bremen;

Thence, South 89° 25° 20" East along the center line of Pearl Street, a distance of 56.00 feet to a P.K. nail found;

Thence.North 00° 02° 25" East, a distance of 29.70 feet to an iron bar found in the north R/W line of Pearl Street;

Thence, South 89° 25° 20" East along the north R/W line of Rearl Street, a distance of 110.00 feet to an iron bar found:

Thence, North 00° 02° 25" East, a distance of 129.00 feet to an iron pipe found and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described:

Thence, North 89° 25' 20" West, a distance of 155.27 feet to an iron bar found in the eastern R/W line of County Road # 66-A:

Thence, North 37° 52° 50" West along the eastern R/W line of County Road # 66-A, a distance of 235.59 feet to a point:

Thence, South 89° 27° East, a distance of 300.10 feet to a iron pipe set, passing through an iron bar found at 6.38 feet:

Thence South 00° 02° 25" West, a distance of 184.60 feet to an iron pipe found and the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 0.9649 Acre and being subject to all legal easements and rights-of-way of record.
