Being a parcel of land situated in Out Lots 126 and 127 in the City of St. Marys, and also situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 2 and the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 3, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at an iron bar at the northwest corner of said Section 2-

Thence, south 00°03'21" west, along the west line of the northwest quarter of said Section 2, a distance of thirty (30.00) feet to the southwest corner of a 0.4038 acre tract of land conveyed to the City of St. Marys by deed recorded in Deed Volume 232, Page 631. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument—

Thence, continuing south 00°03'21" west, along the last described line, a distance of six hundred twenty-eight and 18/100 (628.18) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, north 89°48'22" west, a distance of four hundred two and 05/100 (402.05) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar in the east line of Scott Street-

Thence, south, along said east line of Scott Street, a distance of fifty (50.00) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, south 89°48'22" east, a distance of four hundred sixty-two (462.00) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, south 00°03'21" west, a distance of five hundred eighty-five and 14/100 (585.14) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar in the north right-of-way line of the Chain Factory spur formally owned by L. E. and W. Railroad Company as described in Deed Volume 58, Page 66-

Thence, north 89°33'13" east, along said north right-of-way line, a distance of two hundred sixty-nine and 89/100 (269.89) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, north $00^{\circ}26'47"$ west, along an offset in said right-of-way line, a distance of two and 50/100 (2.50) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, northeasterly along a curve in said right-of-way line, concave to the northwest, having a radius of 701.21 and a delta angle of 28°00', an arc distance of two hundred sixty-three and 11/100 (263.11) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar. The chord to the last described call bears north 78°48'12" east, 261.57 feet-

Thence, north 00°03'21" east, a distance of one thousand two hundred eight and 14/100 (1208.14) feet to a 5/8 inch iron-

Thence, west, along the south line of the aforementioned City of St. Marys tract, a distance of five hundred eighty-six and 40/100 (586.40) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 16.531 acres of land more or less.
