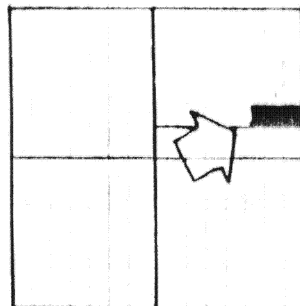

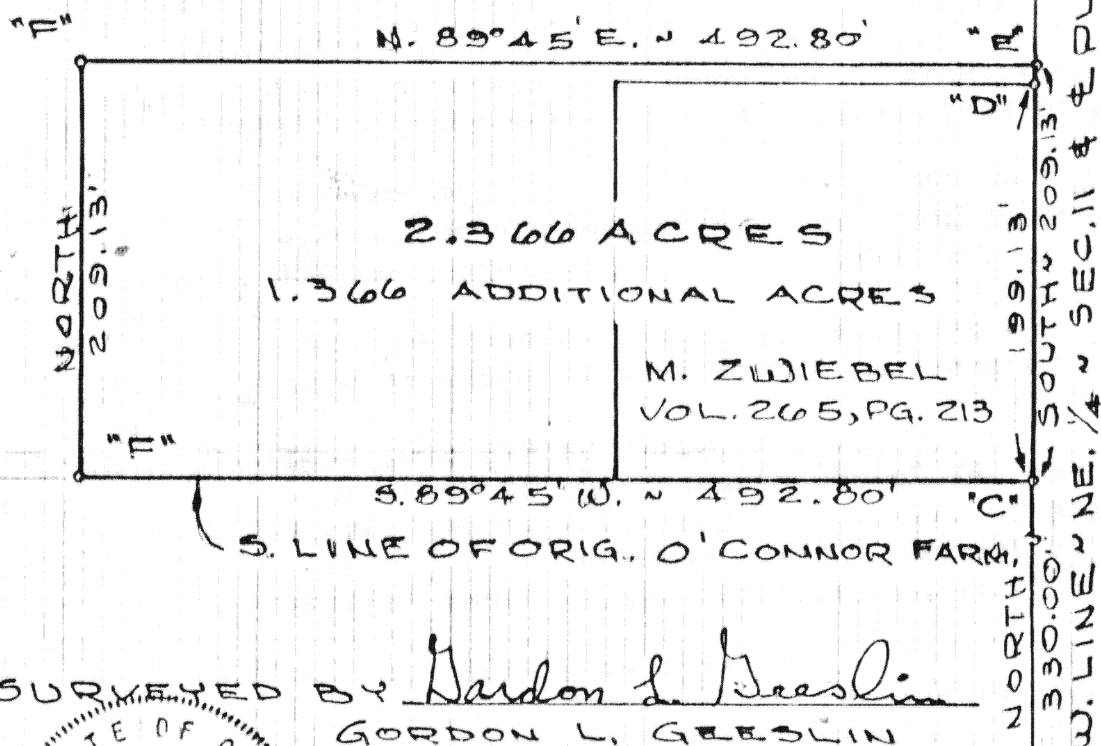
- "A" = IRON IN MON BOX @ E. 1/4 POST ~ SEC. 11.

LOCATION SKETCH

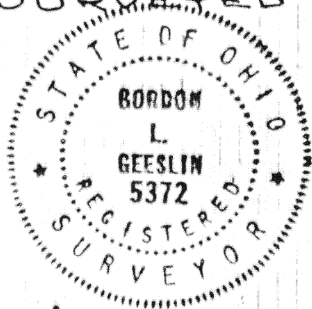


SECTION 11

O'CONNOR SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the northeast quarter of Section 11, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at an iron bar in a monument box at the northeast corner of said Section 11 -

Thence, south, along the east line of the northeast quarter of said Section 11 and the centerline of Plattner Road, a distance of two thousand one hundred sixteen and 08/100 (2116.08) feet to a rail road spike. Said point being the place of beginning for the herein described parcel-

Thence, continuing, south, along the last described line, a distance of two hundred nine and 13/100 (209.13) feet to a railroad date nail -

Thence, south 89°45' west, on and along a line parallel with and three hundred thirty (330.00) north of the south line of the northeast quarter of said Section 11, a distance of four hundred ninety-two and 80/100 (492.80) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar -

Thence, north, a distance of two hundred nine and 13/100 (209.13) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar -

Thence, north 89°45' east, a distance of four hundred ninety-two and 80/100 (492.80) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 2.366 acres of land more or less of which 1.00 acre has previously been conveyed to Michael Zwiebel by deed recorded in deed volume 265, page 213.
