

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situate in the North half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 11, T-5-S, R-7-E, Union Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, and more particularly described as follows;

Commencing at a monument box set over an iron rod at the Northeast corner of said Section 11, (also being the intersection of the centerlines of the Buckland-Holden Road and the Graham Road); thence South zero degrees, five minutes, thirty-eight seconds East (S00°05'38"E), with the East line of said Section 11, (also being the centerline of Graham Road), one thousand, one hundred fifty-three and sixty-nine hundredths (1153.69) feet to a Railroad Spike, being the PLACE OF BEGINNING: thence continuing South zero degrees, five minutes, thirty-eight seconds East (S00°05'38"E) with the East line of said Section 11, (also being the centerline of Graham Road) one hundred seventy-four and zero hundredths (174.00) feet to a Railroad Spike set at the Southeast corner of the North half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 11; thence North eighty-nine degrees, fifty-seven minutes, thirty seconds West (N89°57'30"W) with the South line of the North half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 11, two hundred fifty and thirty-five hundredths (250.35) feet to a 5/8" diameter rebar, passing through a 5/8" diameter rebar set at twenty-three and zero hundredths (23.00) feet; thence North zero degrees, five minutes, thirty-eight seconds West (N00°05'38"W) parallel with the East line of said Section 11, one hundred seventy-four and zero hundredths (174.00) feet to a 5/8" diameter rebar; thence South eighty-nine degrees, fifty-seven minutes, thirty seconds East (S89°57'30"E) parallel with the South line of the North half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 11, two hundred fifty and thirty-five hundredths (250.35) feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, passing through a 5/8" diameter rebar set at two hundred twenty-seven and thirty-five hundredths (227.35) feet, containing 43,560 square feet or 1.000 acres more or less and subject to all legal highways and other easements of record.
