

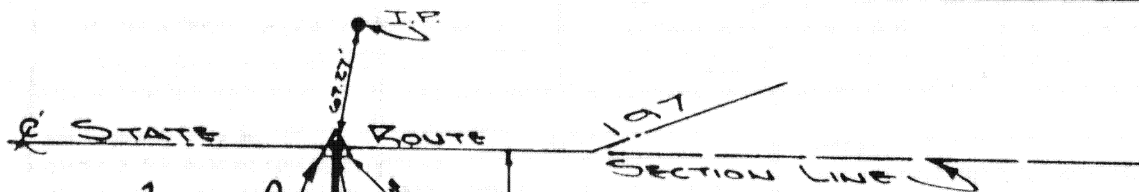

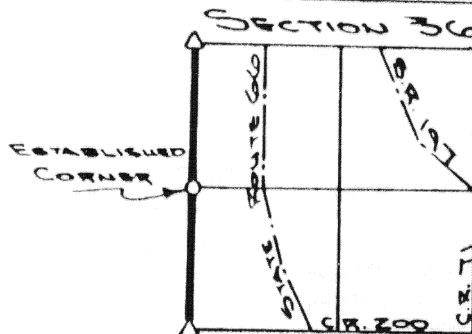

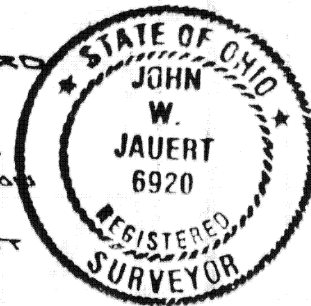
1/2 SECTION LINE
