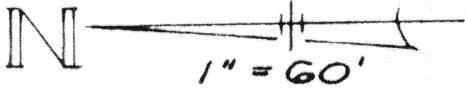


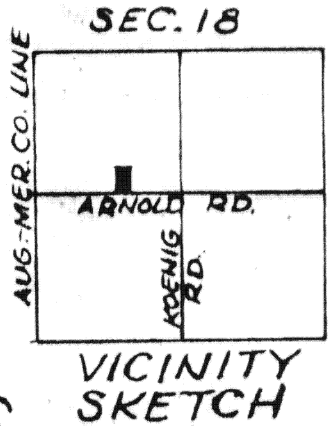
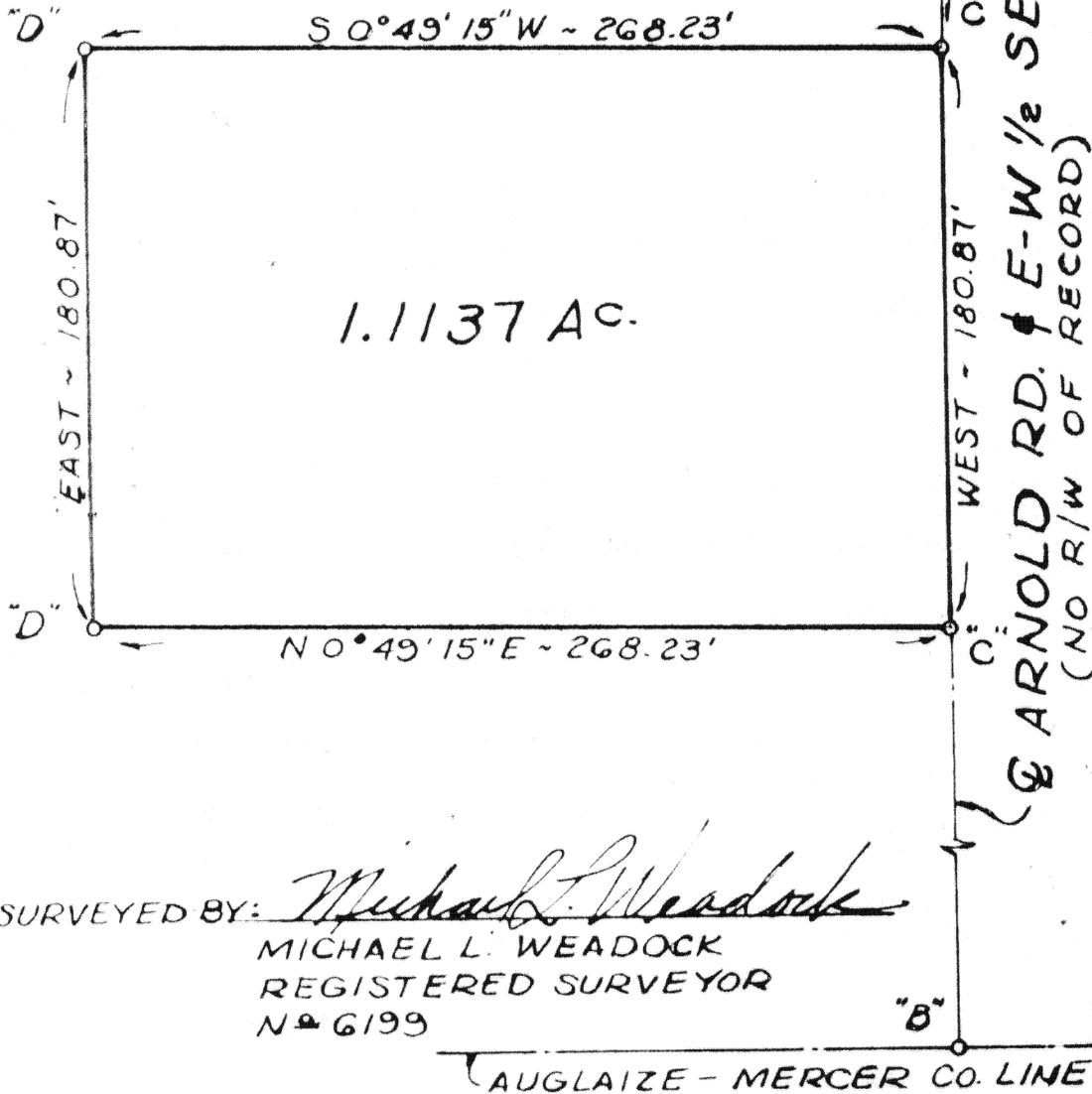

MURRAY DESCRIPTION

Being a part of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 18, T5S, R4E, (Noble Twp.) Auglaize County, Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a monument box at the center of said Section 18, Noble Township, said point also being the intersection of Koenig Road and Arnold Road;

Thence, West, along the centerline of Arnold Road and the east-west 1/2 section line of said Section 18, a distance of nine hundred ninety-nine and 58/100 (999.58) feet to a railroad spike, said point being the place of beginning for following described parcel;

Thence, continuing, West, along the last described line, a distance of one hundred eighty and 87/100 (180.87) feet, to a railroad spike;

Thence, North $0^{\circ} 49' 15''$ East, a distance of two hundred sixty-eight and 23/100 (268.23) feet, to a 5/8" iron bar;

Thence, East, a distance of one hundred eighty and 87/100 (180.87) feet to a 5/8" iron bar;

Thence, S $0^{\circ} 49' 15''$ West, a distance of two hundred sixty-eight and 23/100 (268.23) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 1.1137 acres more or less.


There is no recorded right-of-way for Arnold Road.
