

## LEGAL DESCRIPTION

## 30.00 ACRES

BEING A TRACT OF LAND IN THE SOUTH ONE-HALF OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 17, TOWN 7 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, GERMAN TOWNSHIP, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO, AND BEING MORE FULLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Commencing for reference at a masonry nail over a stone in the northwast corner of said northwast quarter, said nail also at the intersection of S.R. 274 and T.R. 31;

thence, south zero\* 02′ 25" west 1328.71 feet with the east line of the northeast quarter and center line of T.R. 31 to a railroad spike; said spike marking the principal place of beginning of the tract herein conveyed; said spike also being located at the northeast corner of the Schmiesing tract as recorded in Deed Vol, 187, page 11;

thence, continuing, south zero\* 02' 25" west 651.10 feet with the east line of said quarter to a railroad spike;

thence, north 89° 29' 06" west 2006.79 feet to an iron pin;

thence, north zero" 03' 58" west 651.11 feet with the east line of the Schwartz tract as recorded in Deed Vol. 259, page 87 to an iron pin at the grantor's northwest corner;

thence, south 89° 29′ 06" east 2008.00 feet with the south line of the 6 & Y Schmiesing tract as recorded in deed Vol. 158, page 31 to the principal place of beginning, containing 30.00 acres, more or less, and subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Grantor acquired title to the above described premises by Deed Vol. 187, page 11 as recorded in Auglaize County, Ohio.
