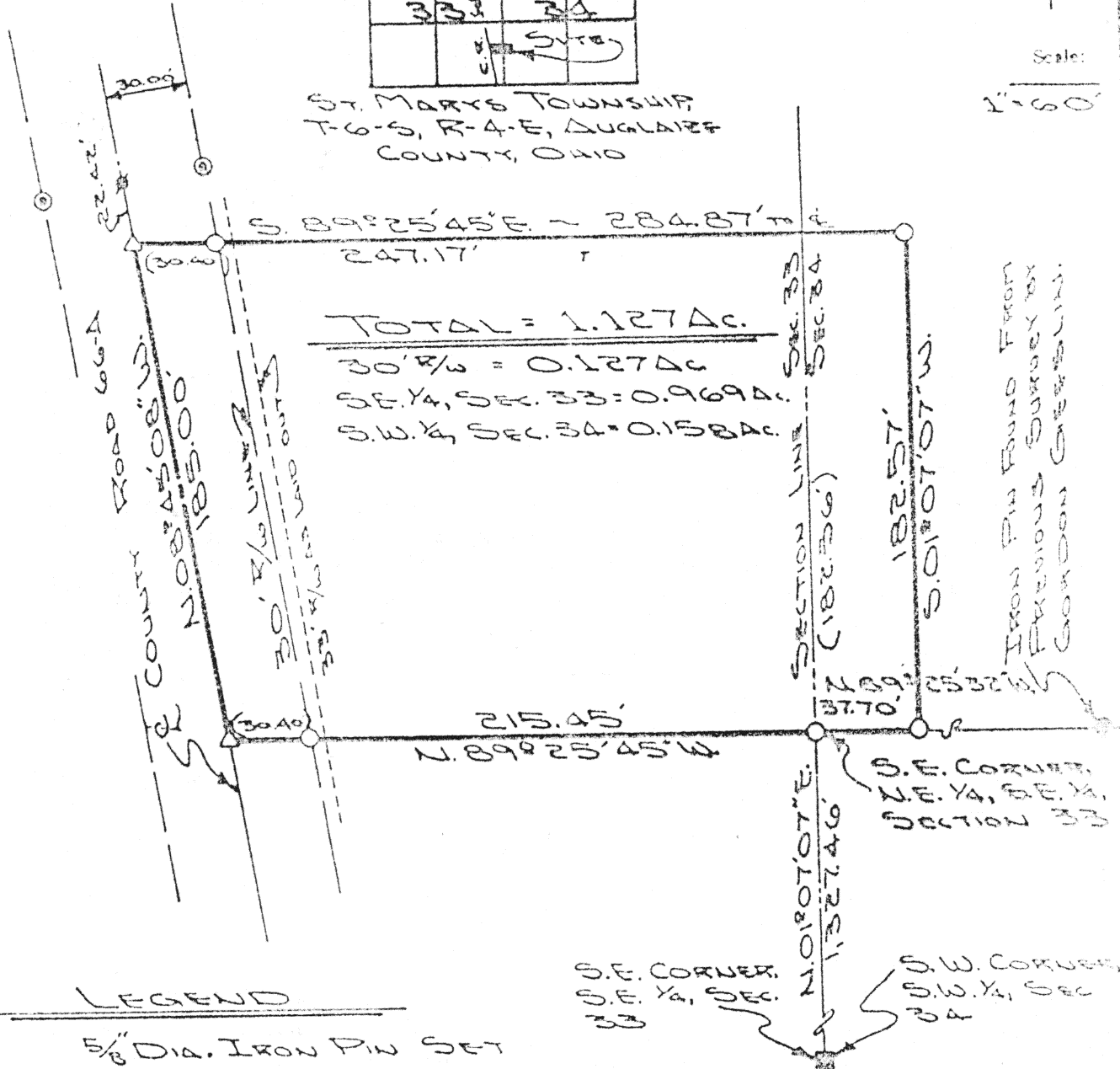

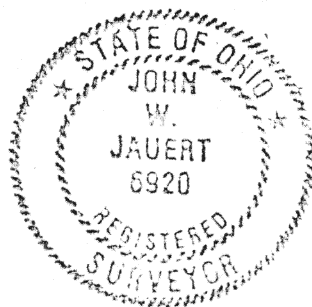

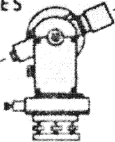

SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION

The following described tract of land is part Southeast Quarter of Section 33 and part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 34, Town 6 South, Range 4 East, St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box over the stone at the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, St. Marys Township and in the centerline of County Road 80 (Clover Four Road);

thence N.01°07'07"E. along the East line of Section 33, a distance of 1,327.46 feet to an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, St. Marys Township, said iron pin being the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land here-in described;

thence N.89°25'45"W. along the South line of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, St. Marys Township, a distance of 215.45 feet to a R.R. spike in the centerline of County Road 66-A, passing thru an iron pin at 185.05 feet in the East right-of-way line of County Road 66-A;

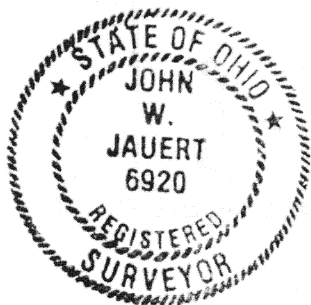
thence N.08°45'08"W. along the centerline of County Road 66-A a distance of 185.00 feet to a R.R. spike;

thence S.89°25'45"E., parallel to the South line of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, St. Marys Township, a distance of 284.87 feet to an iron pin, passing thru an iron pin at 30.40 feet in the East right-of-way line of County Road 66-A, also passing thru the Section line at 247.17 feet;

thence S.01°07'07"W. a distance of 182.57 feet to an iron pin in the South line of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 34, St. Marys Township;

thence N.89°25'32"W. along the South line of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 34, St. Marys Township, a distance of 37.70 feet to an iron pin which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 1.127 acres of which 0.127 acre has been dedicated for highway purposes, 0.969 acre being in the Southeast Quarter of Section 33 and 0.158 acre being in the Southwest Quarter of Section 34, St. Marys Township. The above described tract of land is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed references: volume 244, page 819 and volume 148, page 4, in the Auglaize County Recorder's Office. This plat is recorded in Survey Book H, page 136, in the Auglaize County Engineer's Office.
