

SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION

The following described tract of land is part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33, Town 4 South, Range 6 East, Duchouquet Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box at the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 208 (National Road) and Township Road 161 (Hauss Road);

thence N.01°04'30"E. along the centerline of Township Road 161 a distance of 506.42 feet to a P.K. nail set and the PLACE OF BEGINNING;

thence N.88°25'30"W. a distance of 360.06 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N.01°04'30"E., parallel to the centerline of Township Road 161, a distance of 128.00 feet to an iron pin set;

thence S.88°25'30"E. a distance of 360.06 feet to a R.R. spike found;

thence S.01°04'30"W. along the centerline of Township Road 161, a distance of 128.00 feet to a P.K. nail which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 1.06 acre of which 0.06 acre has been dedicated for highway purposes. The above described tract of land is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed reference: Volume 207 , page 308 . This plat is recorded in Survey Book "H", page 245 , in the Auglaize County Engineer's Office.
