

SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION

The following described tract of land is part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 5, Town 6 South, Range 8 East, Goshen Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

The PLACE OF BEGINNING is at a monument box at the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 5, Goshen Township, and in the centerline of County Road 261 (Waynesfield Road);

thence N.00°00'30"W. along the centerline of County Road 261 and the West line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 5, Goshen Township, a distance of 210.44 feet to a R.R. spike set;

thence N.89°52'E., parallel to the half Section line of Section 5, a distance of 232.00 feet to an iron pin set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 25.00 feet in the East right-of-way line of County Road 261;

thence S.00°00'30"E., parallel to the centerline of County Road 261 and the West line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section, a distance of 210.44 feet to an iron pin set;

thence S.89°52'W. along the South line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 5, Goshen Township, a distance of 232.00 feet to a monument box, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 207.00 feet in the East-right-of-way line of County Road 261, said monument box was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 1.121 acre of which 0.121 acre has been dedicated for highway purposes. The above described tract of land is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed reference: Volume 195, page 74. This plat is recorded in Survey Book "H", page _276___, in the Auglaize County Engineer's Office.
