thence N.89°56'50"W. along the centerline of County Road 130 (Washington Pike), and the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 12, St. Marys Township, a distance of 482.82 feet to a R.R. spike set, which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

the tract of land herein described,
thence S.00°39'24"W. a distance of 452.00 feet to an iron pin, passing thru an
iron pin set for reference at 25.00 feet in the South right-of-way line of County

Road 130; thence N.89°56'50"W., parallel to the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 12, St. Marys Township, a distance of 482.82 feet to a point;

thence N.00°39'24"E. a distance of 452.00 feet to a point in the centerline of

County Road 130; thence S.89°56'50"E. along the centerline of County Road 130 and the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 12, St. Marys Township, a distance of 482.82 feet to a R.R. spike which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 5.01 acre of which 0.28 acre has been dedicated for highway purposes. The above described tract of land is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed reference: Volume OR 41, page 261.
