thence S.05°46'E. along the West right-of-way line of County Road 25-A, a distance of 42.00 feet to a point;

thence S.84°14'W., a distance of 10.00 feet to a point;

thence N.05°46'W., parallel to the West right-of-way line of County Road 25-A, a distance of 42.00 feet to a point;

thence N.06°32'08"W., parallel to the West right-of-way line of County Road 25-A, a distance of 7.37 feet to a point;

thence N.83°27'52"E. a distance of 10.00 feet to a point;

thence S.06°32'08"E. a long the West right-of-way line of County Road 25-A, a distance of 7.50 feet to a concrete right-of-way monument, which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 0.011 acre and being subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed reference: Volume 202, page 924. This plat is recorded in Survey Book "H", page 480, in the Auglaize County Engineer's Office.
