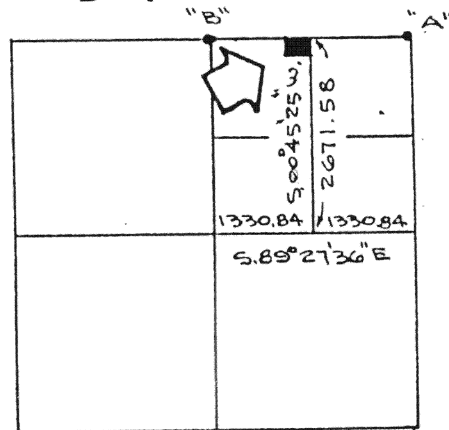


LEGEND

- "D" = 5/8" x 30" IRON BAR SET.

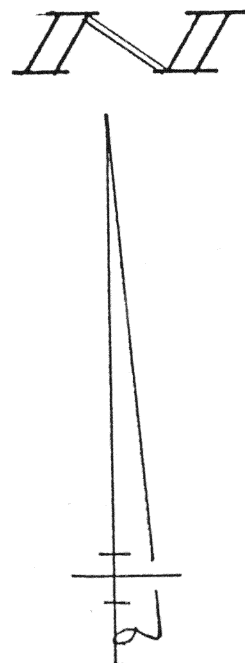
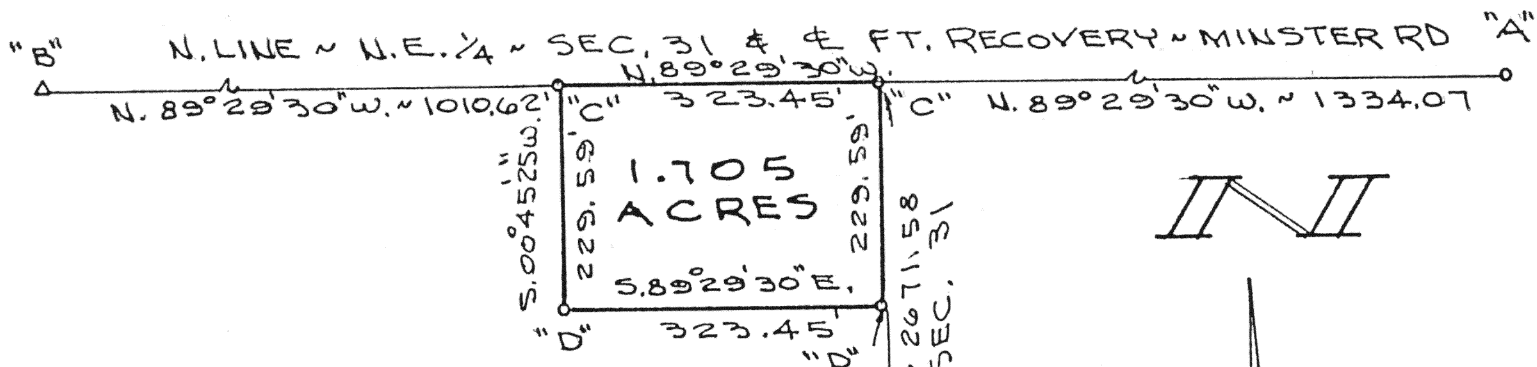
LOCATION SKETCH

WENDELN SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in Jackson Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 31, Township 7 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a railroad spike at the northeast corner of said Section 31-

Thence, north 89°29'30" west, along the north line of the northeast quarter of said Section 31 and the centerline of Fort Recovery - Minster Road, a distance of one thousand three hundred thirty-four and 07/100 (1334.07) feet to a mine spike. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument-

Thence, continuing north 89°29'30" west, along the last described line, a distance of three hundred twenty-three and 45/100 (323.45) feet to a mine spike-

Thence, south 00°45'25" west, a distance of two hundred twenty-nine and 59/100 (229.59) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, south 89°29'30" east, a distance of three hundred twenty-three and 45/100 (323.45) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar in the east line of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section 31-

Thence, north 00°45'25" east, along said east line of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter, a distance of two hundred twenty-nine and 59/100 (229.59) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 1.705 acres of land more or less of which 0.223 is road right-of-way.
