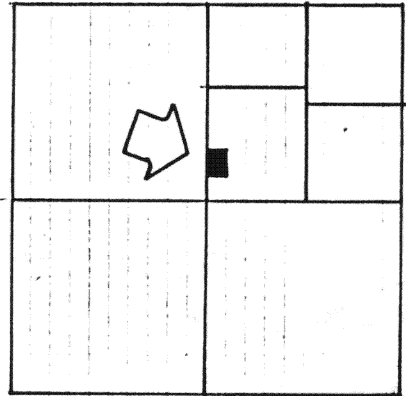
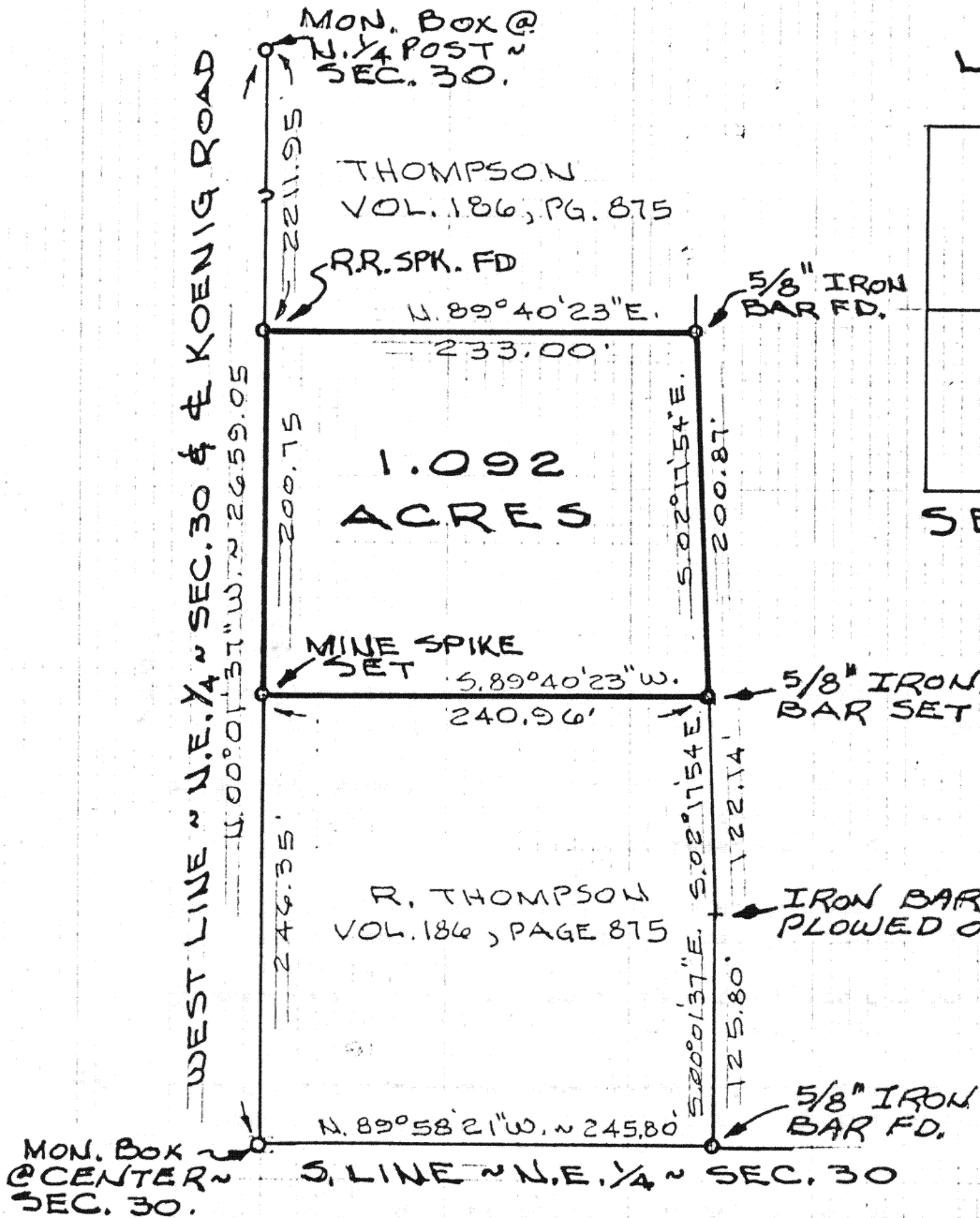
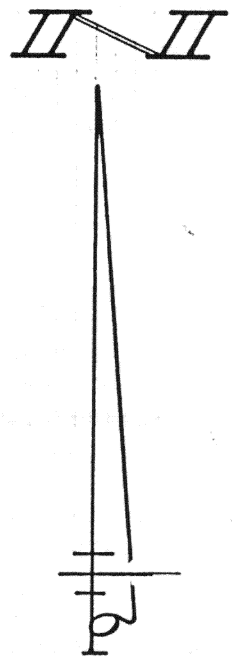

SMITH SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in Noble Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the west half of the northeast quarter of Section 30, Town 5 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at an iron bar in the monument box at the center of said Section 30-

Thence, north $00^{\circ}01'37''$ west, along the west line of the northeast quarter of said Section 30 and the centerline of Koenig Road, a distance of two hundred forty-six and $35/100$ (246.35) feet to a mine spike. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument-

Thence, continuing north $00^{\circ}01'37''$ west, along the last described line, a distance of two hundred and $75/100$ (200.75) feet to a railroad spike at the southwest corner of a 1.12 acre tract of land conveyed to Robert and Janet Thompson by deed recorded in Deed Volume 186, page 875-

Thence, north $89^{\circ}40'23''$ east, along said Thompson's south line, a distance of two hundred thirty-three (233.00) feet to a $5/8$ inch iron bar at the southeast corner thereof-

Thence, south $02^{\circ}17'54''$ east, a distance of two hundred and $87/100$ (200.87) feet to a $5/8$ inch iron bar-


Thence, south $89^{\circ}40'23''$ west, a distance of two hundred forty and $96/100$ (240.96) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 1.092 acres of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.
