

The following described tract of land is part of the North half of Section 1, Town 5 South, Range 4 East, Salem Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a R.R. spike found at the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 200 (Barber - Werner Road) and State Route 66, centerline station 1043+71.20 as found on the O.D.O.T. right-of-way plans AUG. -66-17.27;

thence  $5.26^{\circ}28'E$ . along the centerline of State Route 66 a distance of 957.40 feet to a point (C.L. sta. 1034+13.80), which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence continuing S.26°28'E. along the centerline of State Route 66, a

distance of 308.32 feet to a point (C.L. sta. 1031+05.48); thence S.63°32'W. a distance of 181.85 feet to an iron pin set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 48.62 feet in the Westerly right-ofway line of State Route 66;

thence N.26°28'W., parallel to the centerline of State Route 66, a distance of 308.32 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N.63°32'E. a distance of 181.85 feet to a point, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 140.02 feet in the Westerly right-of-way line of State Route 66, said point was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 1.28 acre of which 0.28 acre has been dedicated for highway purposes. The above described tract of land is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed reference: Yolume 237, page 822.
