

The following described tract of land is part of the South half of Section 2, Town 5 South, Range 6 East, Duchouquet Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 2, Duchouquet Township and in the centerline of County Road 190 (Buckland-Holden Road);

thence N.04°00′25"E. a distance of 799.66 feet to an iron pin set, which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described; thence N.89°43′46"W. a distance of 244.85 feet to an iron pin set in

the Southeasterly right-of-way line of Interstate 75; thence N.28°09'00"E. along the Southeasterly right-of-way line of Interstate 75, a distance of 536.93 feet to an iron pin set;

thence S.01° 01'19"W. a distance of 474.65 feet to an iron pin which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.
