

Commencing at a R.R. spike at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 23, Washington Township and in the centerline of State



thence N.89°11′00″E. a distance of 19.00 feet to an iron pin found;
thence N.00°07′35″W. a distance of 281.07 feet to a 6 inch dia. wooden

thence S.83°20′50°E. a distance of 135.28 feet to an iron pin set; thence S.00°08′16°E. a distance of 463.43 feet to a P.K. nail, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 25.00 feet in the North right-of-way line of State Route 219;


