



The following described tract of land is part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, Town 5 South, Range 6 East, Duchouquet Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box at the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, Duchouquet Township and in the centerline intersection of County Road 190 (Buckland-Holden Road) and Township Road 161 (Hauess Road);

thence with an assumed bearing of N. 00° 30' E. along the centerline of Township Road 161 and the East line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, a distance of 25.00 feet to a point;
thence N. 89° 42' 50" W. a distance of 20.00 feet to a point which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;
thence continuing N. 89° 42' 50" W. along the North right-of-way line of County Road 190, a distance of 10.00 feet to a point;
thence N. 00° 30' E., parallel to the West right-of-way line of Township Road 161, a distance of 10.00 feet to a point;
thence S. 89° 42' 50" E., parallel to the North right-of-way line of County Road 190, a distance of 10.00 feet to a point;
thence S. 00° 30' W. along the West right-of-way line of Township Road 161, a distance of 10.00 feet to a point which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 100 square feet or 0.002 acre. This plat is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, of record or in use on said premises.
