SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION FOR FORTMAN PROPERTY

The following described tract of ground is part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 34, Township 5 South, Range 4 East, Noble Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

thence N.01°08'55"E. through an iron pin found at 26.00 feet in the North right-of-way line of Township Road 140 for a total distance of 35.00 feet to an iron pin found in the right-of-way line of State Route 33 and the State Route 66 interchange;

thence N.10°56'50"E. along the South right-of-way line of State Route 33, a distance of 185.05 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N.55°41'43"E. along said right-of-way line, a distance of 887.26 feet to an iron pin set; thence S.89°46'09"E. along the Kuck-Fortman property line, a distance
