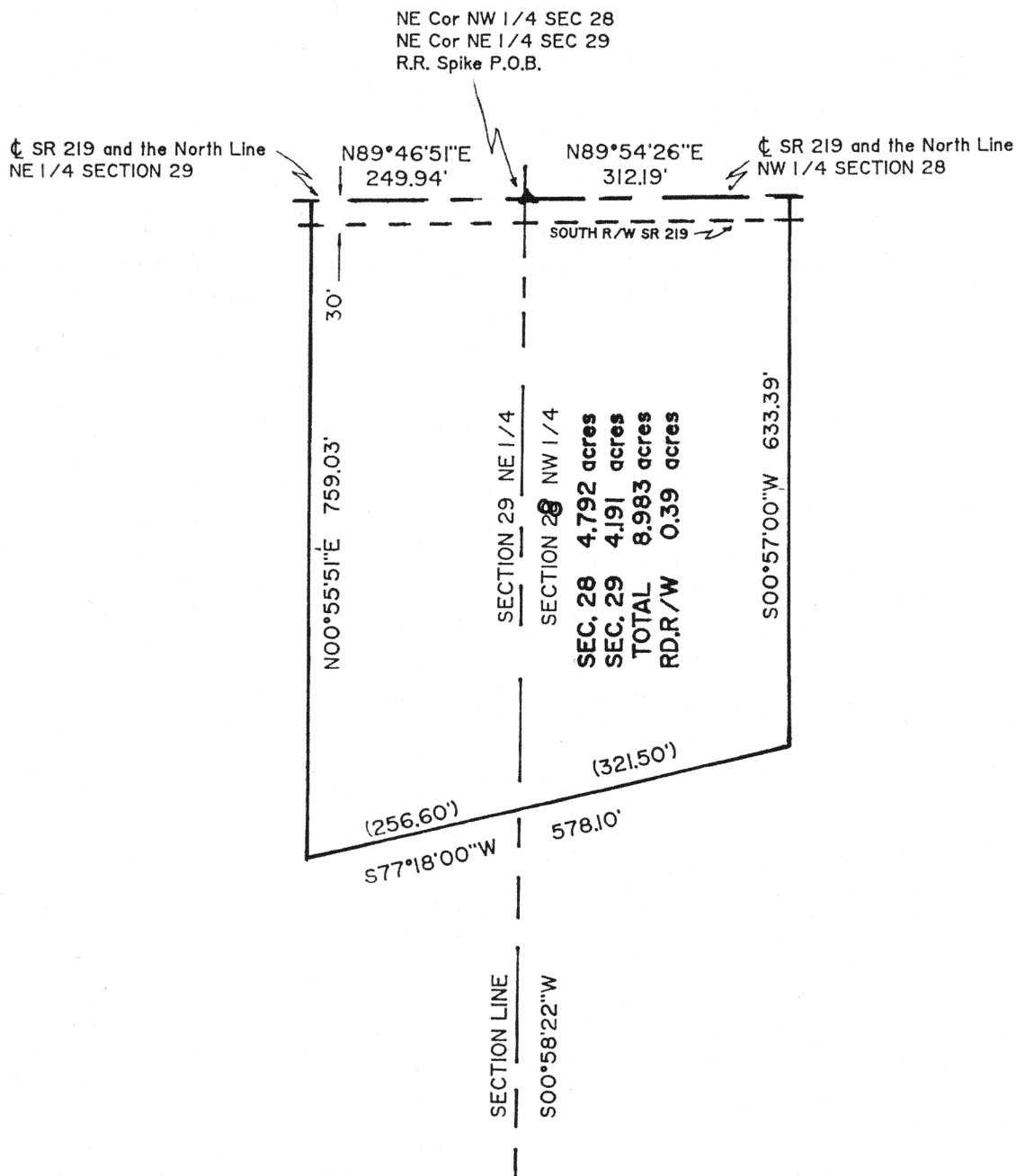


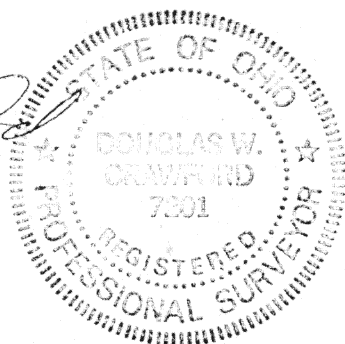

The following described tract of land is located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 28 and the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, T6S, R5E, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

The PLACE OF BEGINNING being a railroad spike at the Northwest Corner of said Section 28, and being in the centerline of SR 219;

Thence N89°54'26"E, along the north line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 28 and the centerline of SR 219, a distance of 312.19 feet to a point;

Thence S00°57'00"W, a distance of 633.39 feet to a point;

Thence S77°18'00"W, entering the Northeast Quarter of said Section 29 at 321.50 feet, a total distance of 578.10 feet to a point;

Thence N00°55'51"E, a distance of 759.03 feet, to a point on the north line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 29 and being in the centerline of SR 219;

Thence N89°46'52"E, along the north line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 29 and the centerline of SR 219, a distance of 249.94 feet, to a railroad spike at the Northeast Corner of said Section 29, which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 8.983 acres, of which 0.39 acres is subject to the right-of-way of SR 219, and 4.792 acres are in the Northwest Quarter of Section 28 and 4.191 acres are in the Northeast Quarter of Section 29.
