

The following described tract of land is part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Town 7 South, Range 4 East, Jackson Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a P.K. nail found at the West Quarter corner of Section 35, Jackson Township and in the centerline of State Route 66;

thence N.89°51'38"E. along the East-West half Section line (as per survey by Allen & Associates, June, 1984), a distance of 600.40 feet to an iron pin found;

thence S.01°21'07"W. a distance of 916.90 feet to a chiseled "X" on top of an existing manhole ring, which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence S.89°46'46"E. a distance of 352.45 feet to an iron pin set; thence S.01°21'07"W. a distance of 200.00 feet to an iron pin set; thence N.89°46'46"W. a distance of 352.45 feet to an iron pin set; thence N.01°21'07"E. a distance of 200.00 feet to the chiseled "X" in the top of the manhole ring which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 1.618 acre and is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed reference: Volume 89, page 291. This plat is recorded in Survey Book "I", page 296, in the Auglaize County-Engineer's Office.
