

Commencing at a monument box at the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, St. Marys Township and in the centerline of County Road 61 (Plattner Pike);


thence N.61°08'20"E. a distance of 1,594.72 feet to a R.R. spike set in the centerline of Township Road 96-A (Henschen Road), which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence S.37°03'00"E. along the centerline of Township Road 96-A, a distance of 563.79 feet to a R.R. spike found;

thence N.71°11'20"W. a distance of 461.08 feet to an iron pin set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 53.46 feet in the Westerly right-of-way line of Township Road 96-A;

right-of-way line of Township Road 96-A; thence N.17°48'17"E. a distance of 316.45 feet to a R.R. spike, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 279.76 feet in the Westerly right-ofway line of Township Road 96-A, said R.R. spike was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.
