

The following described tract of land is part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of Section 19, Town 4 South, Range 5 East, Logan Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a P.K. nail found in the center of an obliterated concrete corner post at the Northwest corner of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of Section 19;

thence S.00°39'09"W. along the West line of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of Section 19, a distance of 1,000.36 feet to an iron pin set, which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence S.89°30'E., parallel to the centerline of County Road 228 (Deep Cut Road), a distance of 156.11 feet to an iron pin set;

thence S.00°39'09"W., parallel to the West line of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of Section 19, a distance of 309.03 feet to a R.R. spike set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 279.03 feet in the North right-of-way line of County Road 228;

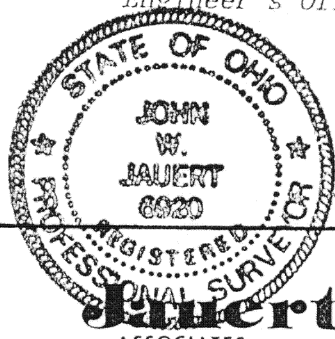
thence N.89°30'W. along the centerline of County Road 228, a distance of 156.11 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N.00°39'09"E. along the West line of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of Section 19, a distance of 309.03 feet to the iron pin which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

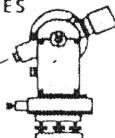
