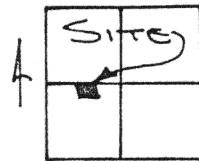


LOCATION PLAN

SECTION 14

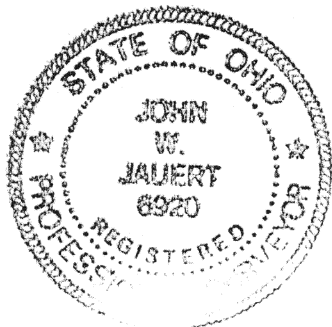

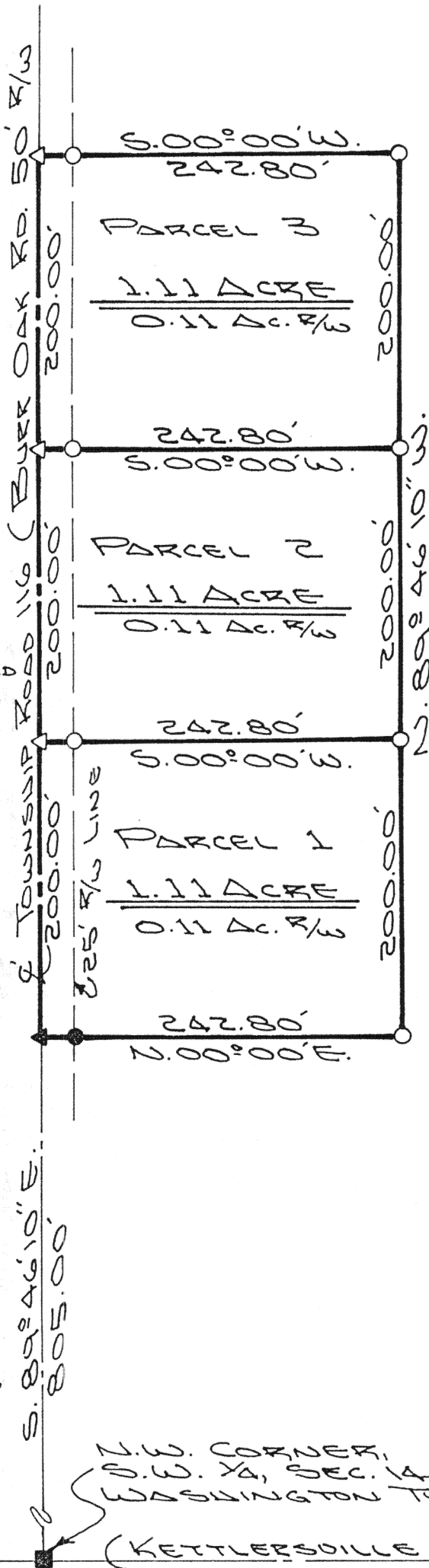
