

The following described tract of land is part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2, Town 6 South, Range 5 East, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

The PLACE OF BEGINNING is at a monument box found at the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Moulton Township and in the centerline of County Road 111 (Kettlersville Road);

thence N.89°17'45"E, along the North line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2, Washington Township, and the North right-of-way line of the abandoned New York Central Railroad, a distance of 396.00 feet to a point;

thence S.00°00'45"W. a distance of 50.00 feet to a point;

thence S.89°17'45"W. along the South right-of-way line of the abandoned New York Central Railroad, a distance of 395.34 feet to a point;

thence S.89°13'24"W. along the South line of the abandoned New York Central Railroad, a distance of 16.00 feet to a point;

thence N.00°16'15"W. along the West line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2, Washington Township, a distance of 50.00 feet to an iron bar found at the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2;

thence N.89°13'24"E. along the North line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2 and the to the monument box which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.
