

The following described tract of land is part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, Town 5 South, Range 4 East, Noble Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box at the Northeast corner of Section 9, Noble Township and in the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 41-A (St. Marys River Road) and Township Road 190 (Salem-Noble Road);

thence S.89°27'00"W. along the centerline of Township Road 190 and the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, a distance of 638.98 feet to a R.R. spike set and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence S.00°36'50"E. a distance of 330.00 feet to an iron pin set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 20.00 feet in the South right-of-way line of Township Road 190;

thence S.89°27'00"W., parallel to the centerline of Township Road 190 and the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, a distance of 396.00 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N.00°36'50"W. a distance of 330.00 feet to a R.R. spike found, passing thru an iron pin found for reference at 310.00 feet in the South right-of-way line of Township Road 190;

thence N.89°27'00"E. along the centerline of Township Road 190 and the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, a distance of 396.00 feet to the R.R. spike which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in 3.00 acre of which 0.18 acre has been dedicated for highway purposes. The above described tract of land is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any of record or in use on said premises. Previous Deed reference: Volume 226, page 118.
