

The following described tract of land is part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Town 6 South, Range 5 East, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box at the Northwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14 and in the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 111 (Kettlersville Road) and Township Road 116 (Burr Oak Road);

thence S.89°46'10"E. along the centerline of Township Road 116 and the North line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Washington Township, a distance of 805.00 feet to a R.R. spike found;

thence S.00°00'W. along the West line of Parcel No. 1 as shown on Survey Plat 92-704, recorded in Survey Book "I", page 483, in the Auglaize County Engineer's Office, a distance of 242.80 feet to an iron pin found, which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence S.89°46'10"E., parallel to the centerline of Township Road 116, a distance of 200.00 feet to an iron pin found;

thence S.00°00'W. a distance of 217.80 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N.89°46'10"W., parallel to the centerline of Township Road 116, a distance of 200.00 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N.00°00'E. a distance of 217.80 feet to the iron pin which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 1.00 acre, being subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed reference: Volume 188, page 234. This Survey is recorded in Survey Book "I", page 737, in the Auglaize County Engineer's Office.
