

The following described tract of land is part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, Town 5 South, Range 4 East, Noble Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a R.R. spike found at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, Noble Township and in the centerline of State Route 197;

thence S.89°19'40"E. along the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7 and the centerline of State Route 197, a distance of 999.39 feet to a R.R. spike found, from previous survey, being the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence continuing S.89°19'40"E. along the above described line, a distance of 330.00 feet to a R.R. spike found, from a previous survey;

thence S.00°46'37"W. a distance of 264.00 feet to an iron pin set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 25.00 feet;

thence N.89°19'40"W., parallel to the centerline of State Route 197 and the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, Noble Township, a distance of 330.00 feet to an iron pin set;

thence N.00°46'37"E. a distance of 264.00 feet to a R.R. spike, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 239.00 feet, said R.R. spike was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 2.000 acre of which 0.227 acre has been dedicated for highway purposes. The above described tract of land is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises.
