

The following described parcel of land is situated in the Northwest quarter, Section eleven, Township five South - Range seven East, Union Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a PK nail set in the North line of said quarter and the centerline of Buckland-Holden Road that is one thousand one hundred sixty-eight and fifty hundredths (1168.50) feet East (assumed bearing) of the monument box found at the Northwest corner of said quarter; thence South zero degrees ten minutes fifty-seven seconds West (S0°10'57''W) four hundred six and zero hundredths (406.00) feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " re-rod set; thence East, parallel with the North line, one hundred sixty and ninety-four hundredths (160.94) feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " re-rod set in the East line of the West half of said quarter; thence North zero degrees ten minutes fifty-seven seconds East (N0°10'57"E) on said East line (passing through a twelve inch diameter concrete post found at three hundred seventy-nine and zero hundredths (379.00) feet) four hundred six and zero hundredths (406.00) feet to a PK nail set in the North line of said quarter and the centerline of the Road; thence West on the North line of said quarter, one hundred sixty and ninety-four hundredths (160.94) feet to the place of beginning containing one and fifty hundredths (1.50) acres, more or less, subject to legal highway and all easements and restrictions of record.
