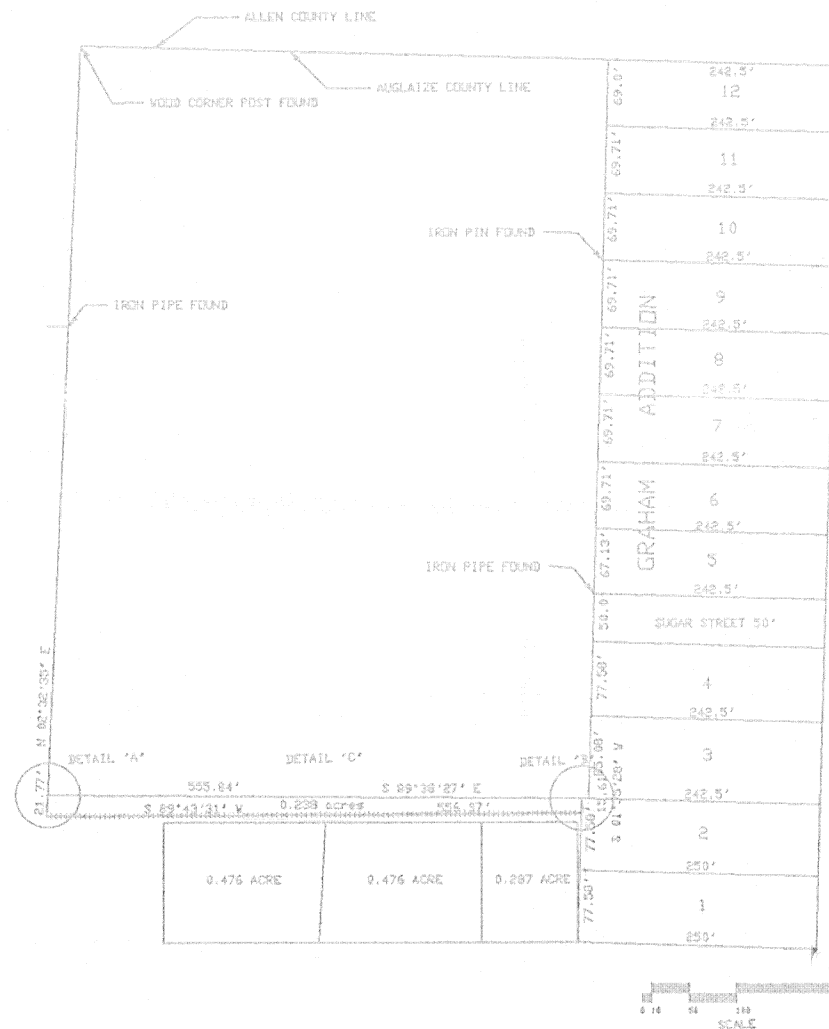
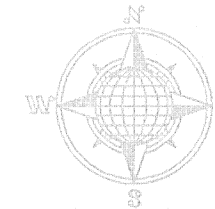
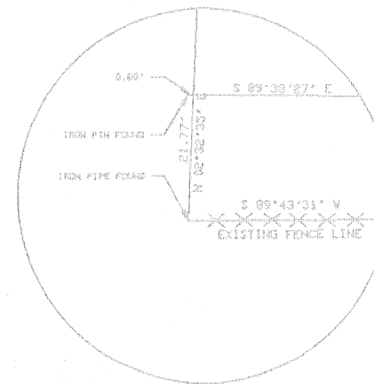


LARRY LOESCHER SURVEY

VILLAGE OF CRIDERSVILLE, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO.



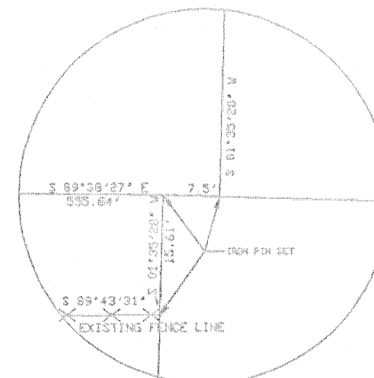
DETAIL "A"

SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION
