

The following described tract of land is part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 20, Town 6 South, Range 6 East, Pusheta Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box at the Southeast corner of Section 20, Pusheta Township and being in the centerline of County Road 100 (Santa-Fe Line Road);

thence S.88°49'30"W. along the centerline of County Road 100 and the South line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 20, Pusheta Township, a distance of 633.40 feet to a R.R. spike found in the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 100 and County Road 25-A;

thence N.06°42'30"W. along the centerline of County Road 25-A, a distance of 2,924.86 feet to a R.R. spike found (from a previous survey) which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence S.89°05'15"W. a distance of 301.63 feet to an iron pin found, passing thru an iron pin found for reference at 45.23 feet in the Westerly Right-of-Way line of County Road 25-A;

thence N.06°42'30"W., parallel to the centerline of County Road 25-A, a distance of 435.34 feet to a point in the centerline of an open ditch, passing thru an iron pin set for reference on the top of the South bank at 420.70 feet;

thence N.88°39'35"E. along the centerline of the open ditch, a distance of 301.41 feet to a P.K. nail set in the centerline of County Road 25-A;

thence S.06°42'30"E. along the centerline of County Road 25-A, a distance of 437.60 feet to the R.R. spike which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.
