

SURVEYORS DESCRIPTION FOR 1.09 ACRE TRACT (SOUTH PARCEL)

THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PARCEL OF LAND IS SITUATED IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 1, UNION TOWNSHIP, TOWN-5-SOUTH, RANGE-7-EAST, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO, AND IS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING FOR REFERENCE AT A MONUMENT BOX LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 1, UNION TOWNSHIP, TOWN-5-SOUTH, RANGE-7-EAST, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO;

THENCE WITH A BEARING OF S. 00°-47'-57" W. ALONG THE WEST LINE OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SAID SECTION 1, UNION TOWNSHIP, AND THE CENTERLINE OF GRAHAM ROAD (TOWNSHIP ROAD #241), FOR A DISTANCE OF 681.75 FEET TO A P.K. NAIL/SHINER AND THE PLACE OF BEGINNING;

THENCE WITH A BEARING OF S. 89°-51'-23" E. FOR A DISTANCE OF 230.69 FEET TO AN IRON PIN, AND PASSING THRU AN IRON PIN FOR REFERENCE AT 20.00 FEET;

THENCE WITH A BEARING OF S. 00° - 40° - 23° W. FOR A DISTANCE OF 204.97 FEET TO AN IRON PIPE;

THENCE WITH A BEARING OF N. $89^{\circ}-51'-23''$ W. FOR A DISTANCE OF 231.14 FEET TO A P.K. NAIL/SHINER, AND PASSING THRU AN IRON PIN FOR REFERENCE AT 211.14 FEET;

THENCE WITH A BEARING OF N. 00° -47'-57" E. ALONG THE WEST LINE OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SAID SECTION 1, UNION TOWNSHIP, AND THE CENTERLINE OF GRAHAM ROAD (TOWNSHIP ROAD #241), FOR A DISTANCE OF 204.97 FEET TO A P.K. NAIL/SHINER AND THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

CONTAINING IN ALL 1.09 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, OF WHICH APPROXIMATELY 0.09 ACRE BEING PREVIOUSLY DEDICATED FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES. THE ABOVE DESCRIBED PARCEL OF LAND IS ALSO SUBJECT TO ALL OTHER LEGAL EASEMENTS, RESERVATIONS, OR RESTRICTIONS, IF ANY, UPON SAID PREMISES.
