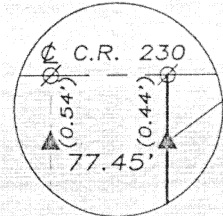

DESCRIPTION FOR 19.969 ACRE  
(Tract 1)

The following described tract of land is part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 21, Town 4 South, Range 4 East, Salem Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a Monument Box in the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 226 (Deep Cut Road) and County Road 41 (St. Marys River Road);

thence N.89°48'41"W. along the centerline of County Road 226 a distance of 1,260.29 feet to a P.K. Nail (set), which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence S.00°46'17"W. a distance of 1,248.35 feet to an 8" Concrete Post, passing thru a R.R. Spike (found) at 0.44 feet;

thence N.89°08'49"W. a distance of 550.28 feet to an Iron Pin (set), passing thru an 8" Concrete Post at 76.72 feet;

thence N.01°06'48"E., parallel to the West line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 21, a distance of 498.34 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

thence N.89°08'49"W. a distance of 334.79 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

thence N.01°56'58"E. a distance of 515.30 feet to an Iron Pin (set);


thence N.89°56'49"E. a distance of 246.76 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

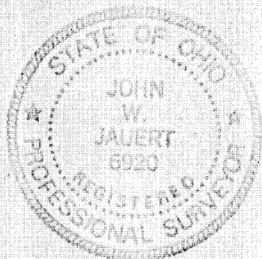
thence N.01°22'34"E. along the centerline of an existing gravel driveway, a distance of 223.70 feet to a P.K. Nail (set);

thence N.89°48'41"W. along the centerline of County Road 226 a distance of 1,882.72 feet to a P.K. Nail (set), which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence S.01°22'34"W. along the centerline of an existing gravel driveway a distance of 223.70 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

thence S.89°56'49"W. a distance of 246.76 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

thence S.01°56'58"W. a distance of 515.30 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

thence S.89°08'49"E. a distance of 334.79 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

thence S.01°06'48"W., parallel to the West line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 21, a distance of 498.34 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

thence N.89°08'49"W. a distance of 856.14 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

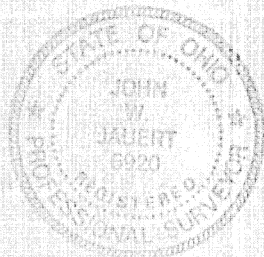
thence N.01°06'48"E. along the West line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 21, a distance of 1,232.14 feet to a P.K. Nail (found);
