



LEGAL DESCRIPTION

scale:

Being a part of the South half of the Southwest quarter of Section 14, T-6-S, R-4-E, Pusheta Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and more particularly described as follows:


Commencing at a re-rod found over a stone at the Southwest corner of said South half of the Southwest quarter of Section 14; thence S 89 degrees 58' 01" E, along the South line of the said Southwest quarter, for a distance of 541.51 feet to a 5/8" re-rod w/cap (set) and the PLACE OF BEGINNING;

thence N 05 degrees 19' 09" W, for a distance of 385.62 feet to a 5/8" re-rod w/cap (set);

thence N 63 degrees 20' 05" E, (passing through a 5/8" re-rod w/cap set on the westerly right-of-way line of the Shelby-Freyburg Road at a distance of 162.46 feet) for a total distance of 182.88 feet, to the centerline of said Road and a cotton gin spindle (set);

thence S 38 degrees 18' 00" E, along the centerline of the Shelby-Freyburg Road, for a distance of 594.21 feet to a 1" iron bar (found) at the intersection of said road with the South line of said Southwest quarter and the centerline of Freyburg-East Road;

thence N 89 degrees 58' 01" W, along said south line of the Southwest quarter, (passing through a 5/8" re-rod w/cap set on the westerly right-of-way line of the Shelby-Freyburg Road at a distance of 25.50 feet) for a total distance of 495.97 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, containing therein 3.407 acres. LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a part of the South half of the Southwest quarter of Section 14, T-6-S, R-4-E, Pusheta Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a re-rod found over a stone at the Southwest corner of said South half of the Southwest quarter of Section 14;

thence N 00 degrees 26' 02" E, along the West line of the said Southwest quarter, for a distance of 763.53 feet to an iron pipe (found) at the Southwest corner of that parcel evidenced by Deed Vol. 250, Pg 312;


thence N 76 degrees 54' 35" E, along the North line of the aforesaid parcel, (passing through a 5/8" re-rod w/cap set on the westerly right-of-way line of Shelby-Freyburg Road at a distance of 349.34 feet) for a total distance of 371.45 feet to a railroad spike (found) on the centerline of said Shelby-Freyburg Road;

thence S 38 degrees 18' 00" E, along the centerline of said Road for a distance of 486.65 feet, to a cotton gin spindle (set);

thence S 63 degrees 20' 05" W, (passing through a 5/8" re-rod w/cap set on the westerly right-of-way line of said Shelby-Freyburg Road at a distance of 20.42 feet) for a total distance of 182.88 feet to a 5/8" re-rod w/cap (set);

thence S 05 degrees 19' 09" E, for a distance of 385.62 to the South line of said Southwest quarter and a 5/8" re-rod w/cap (set);

thence N 89 degrees 58' 01" W, along said South line, for a distance of 541.51 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, containing therein 9.854 acres.
