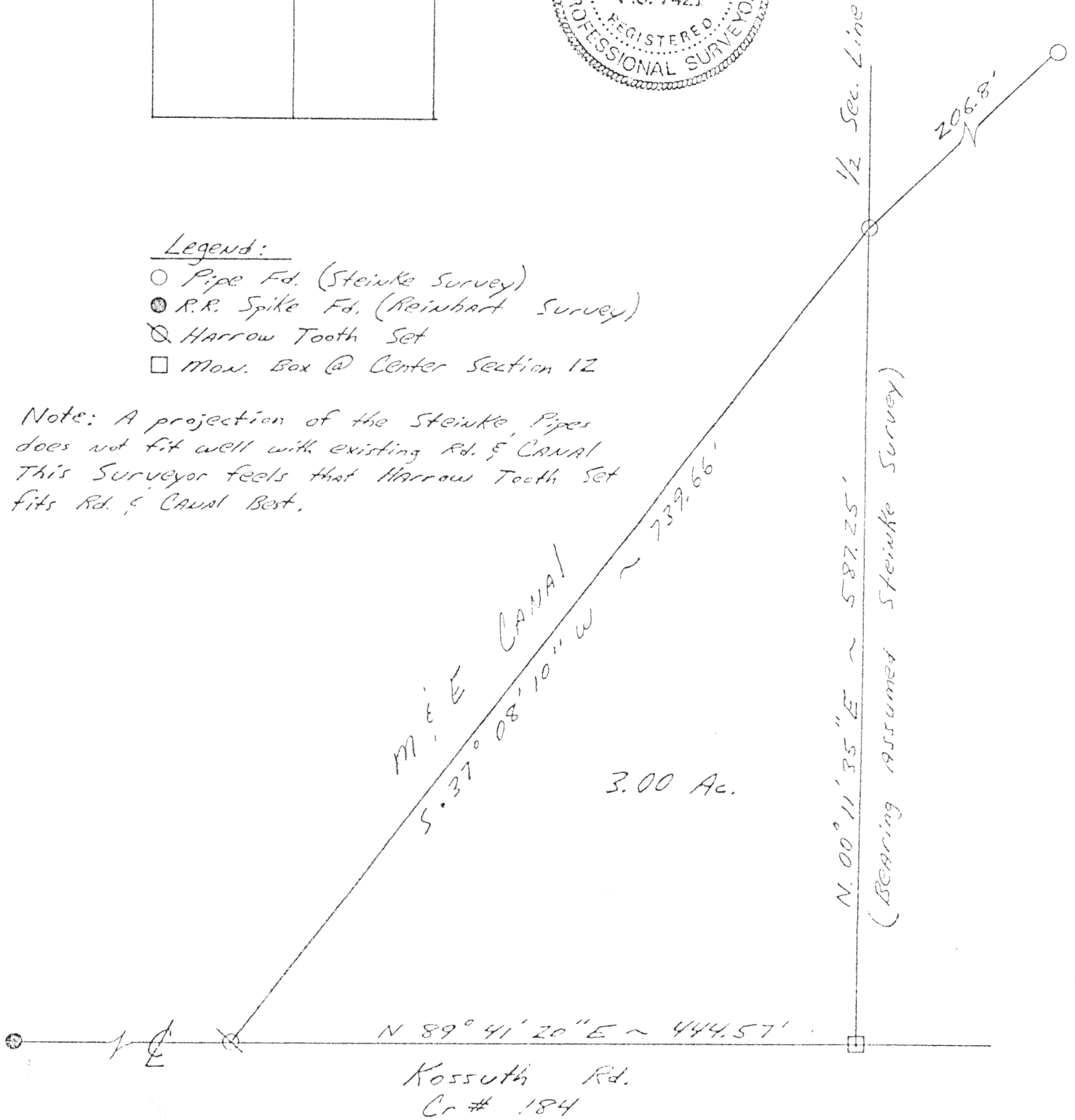

JOHNS SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in Noble Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, and in the northwest quarter of Section 12, Township 5 South, Range 4 East, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box at the center of said Section 12, being the Point of Beginning;

thence N 00° 11' 35" E, 587.25 feet along the east line of the northwest quarter of said Section 12 to an iron pipe found;

thence S 37° 08' 10" W, 739.66 feet along the right-of-way of the Miami & Erie Canal to a harrow tooth set;

thence N 89° 41' 20" E, 444.57 feet along the south line of the northwest quarter of said Section 12 and also being the centerline of County Road #184 to the Point of Beginning.

The afore described parcel of land contains 3.00 acres of land more or less, subject to all valid easements and right-of-way.

All bearings were calculated from angles turned in an actual field survey by Kent B. Marbaugh, Registered Surveyor #7421, dated November 9, 1993, on file in the County Engineer's Office.
