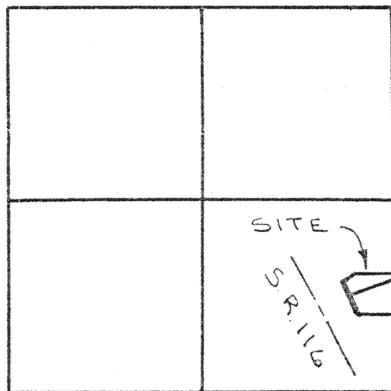


LOCATION
SKETCH

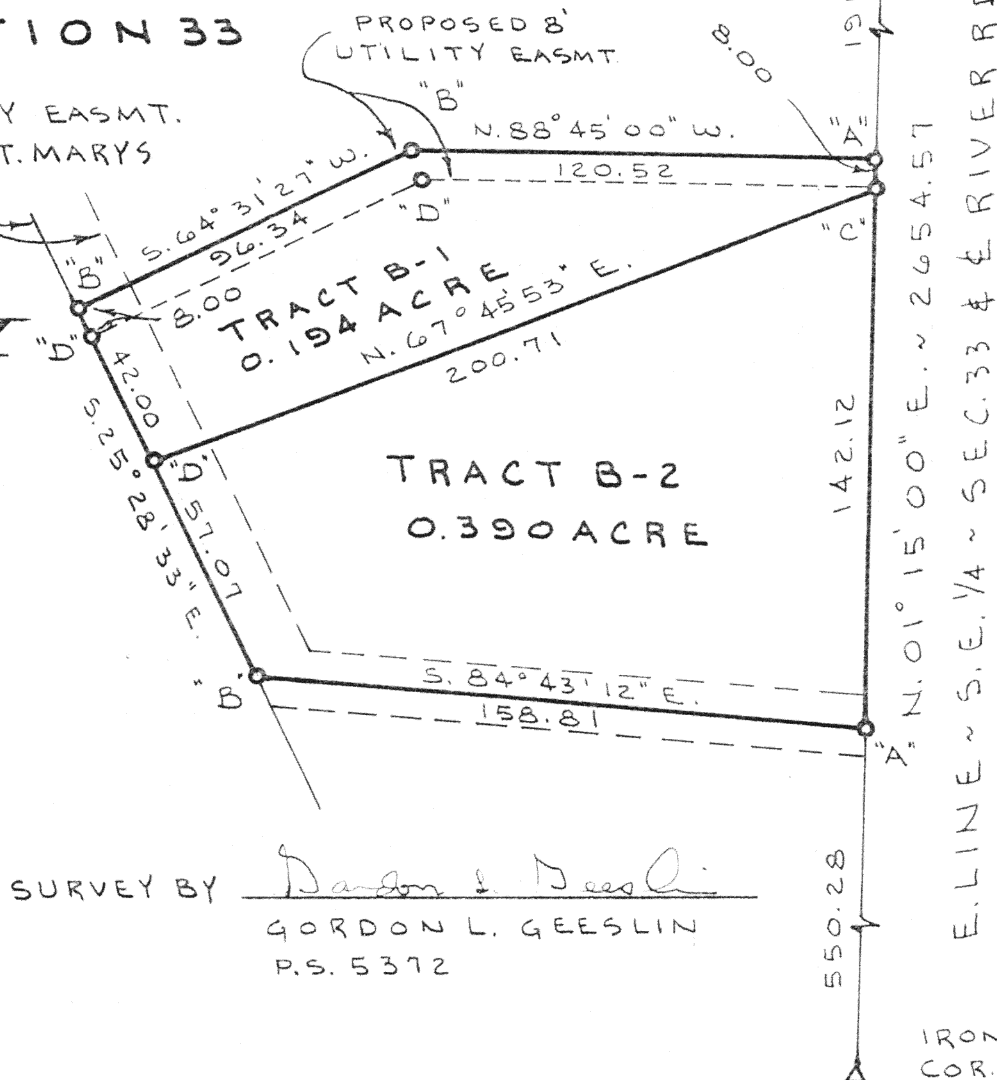
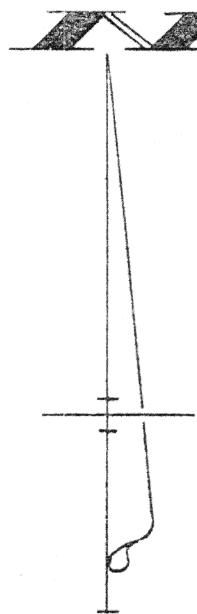


LEGEND

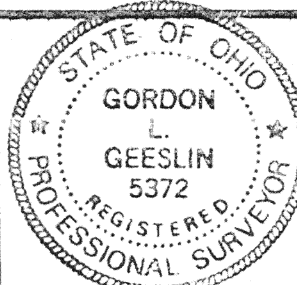

Thence, continuing, north $01^{\circ}15'00''$ east, along the last described line, a distance of one hundred forty-two and $12/100$ (142.12) feet to a P.K. nail-
