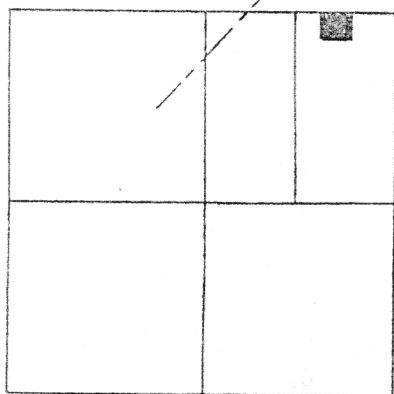


LOCATION SKETCH

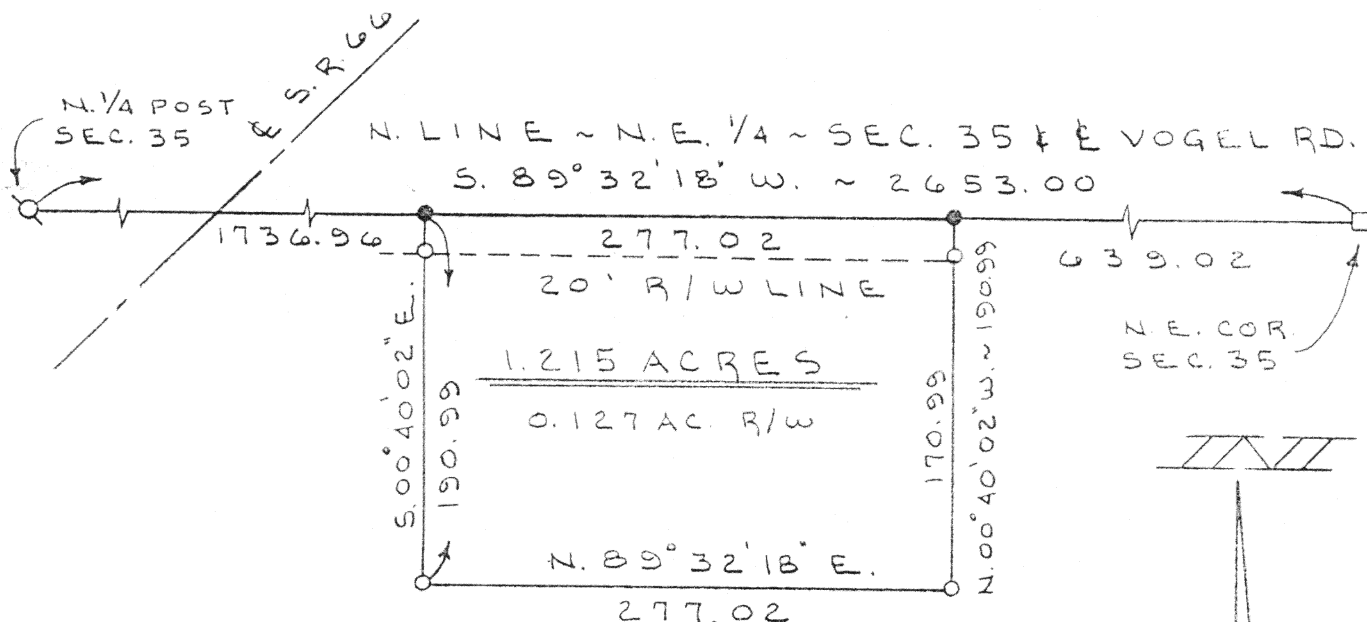

FREEWALT SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in Noble Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the east half of the northeast quarter of Section 35, Township 5 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at an iron bar in an Auglaize County Monument Box Assembly at the northeast corner of said Section 35-

Thence, south $89^{\circ}32'18''$ west, along the north line of the northeast quarter of said Section 35 and the centerline of Vogel Road, a distance of six hundred thirty-nine and $02/100$ (639.02) feet to a mine spike. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument-

Thence, continuing, south $89^{\circ}32'18''$ west, along the last described line, a distance of two hundred seventy-seven and $02/100$ (277.02) feet to a $5/8$ inch iron bar-

Thence, south $00^{\circ}40'02''$ east, a distance of one hundred ninety and $99/100$ (190.99) feet to a $5/8$ inch iron bar-


Thence, north $89^{\circ}32'18''$ east, a distance of two hundred seventy-seven and $02/100$ (277.02) feet to a $5/8$ inch iron bar-

Thence, north $00^{\circ}40'02''$ west, a distance of one hundred ninety and $99/100$ (190.99) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 1.215 acres of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.
