

## LEGAL DESCRIPTION

BEING A PART OF AN 80 ACRE TRACT (OR 63, PAGE 766) IN THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 24, TOWN 7 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, JACKSON TOWNSHIP, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO AND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Commencing for reference at an iron pin in a monument box found at the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of said Section 24;

thence, North 00°-00′-00″ East, 1346.26 feet along the east quarter section line and center of East Shelby Road (TR 71) to a railroad spike set at the Grantor's southeast corner and being the principal place of beginning for the tract herein conveyed;

thence, North 89°-46′-32″ West, 374.00 feet along the Grantor's south line to an iron pin set, and passing for reference at 25.00 feet an iron pin set;

thence, North 00°-00′-00″ East, 175.00 feet to an iron pin set;

thence, South 89°-46′-32″ East, 374.00 feet to a railroad spike set on the east line of said quarter section and center of East Shelby Road (TR71) and passing for reference at 349.00 feet an iron pin set;

thence, South 00°-00′-00″ West. 175.00 feet along the east line of said quarter section and center of East Shelby Road (TR71) to the principal place of beginning. Containing 1.503 acres more or less and being subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

The starting bearing of North  $00^{\circ}$ -00'-00'' East is assumed. Iron pins set are  $5/8 \times 30$  inch rebar with plastic cap stamped T.L.C., L.S. 7100.
