

LEGAL DESCRIPTION GRANTOR: LOUISE LUEDEKE, TRUSTEE GRANTEE: JOHN HAGELBERGER

BEING A PART OF A TRACT OF LAND AS RECORDED IN OFFICIAL RECORD VOLUME 290, PAGE 331 OF THE AUGLAIZE COUNTY DEED RECORDS, SITUATE IN THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 33, TOWN 7 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, JACKSON TOWNSHIP, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO AND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Commencing for reference at an iron pin found in a monument box at the southeast corner of said northeast quarter section, also being in the centerline of Minster-Egypt Pike;

thence, North 88°-51'-39" West, 933.40 feet along the south line of said quarter section and centerline of Minster-Egypt Pike to a P.K. nail set at the Grantor's southeast corner and being the principal place of beginning for the tract herein to be conveyed;

thence, North 88°-51'-39" West, 205.00 feet along the south line of said quarter section and centerline of Minster-Egypt Pike to a P.K. nail set;

thence, North 01°-36'-37" East, 374.10 feet to an iron pin set, passing for reference at 25.00 feet an iron pin set;

thence, South 88°-51'-39" East, 205.00 feet to an iron pin set on the Grantor's east line;

thence, South 01°-36'-37" West, 374.10 feet along the Grantor's east line to the principal place of beginning and passing for reference at 349.10 feet an iron pin set.

Containing 1.761 acres more or less of which 0.118 acres is within existing road right-of-way and being subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Basis of bearing is per a GPS survey as conducted under review of the Auglaize County Engineer's Office, south line of the northeast quarter of Section 33, North 88°-51'-39" West.
