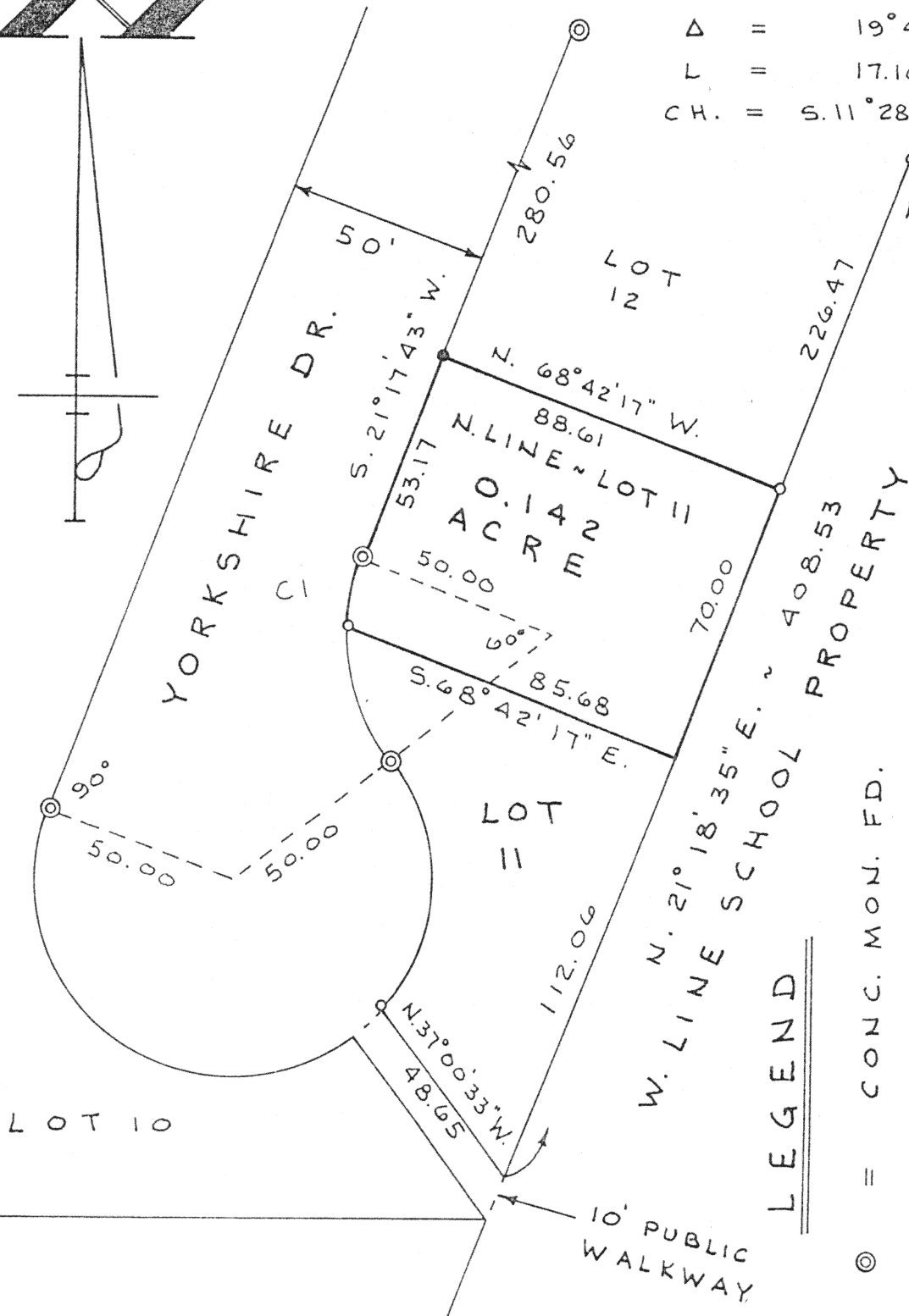

ST. MARYS CITY SCHOOL SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a part of lot number 11 in Meadowview Two, Section Two, in the City of St. Marys, St. Marys Township, Township 6 South Range 4 East, Auglaize County, Ohio:

Beginning at a 5/8 inch iron bar at the northwest corner of said lot number 11-

Thence, south $21^{\circ}17'43''$ west, along the west line of said lot number 11, a distance of fifty-three and 17/100 (53.17) feet to a concrete monument at the point of curvature of a curve to the left having a radius of 50.00 feet and a central angle of $19^{\circ}40'08''$ -

Thence, southerly, along said curve to the left, an arc distance of seventeen and 16/100 (17.16) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar. The chord to the last described call bears south $11^{\circ}28'33''$ west, a distance of 17.08 feet-

Thence, south $68^{\circ}42'17''$ east, a distance of eighty-five and 68/100 (85.68) feet to a point-

Thence, north $21^{\circ}18'35''$ east, a distance of seventy (70.00) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, north $68^{\circ}42'17''$ west, a distance of eighty-eight and 61/100 (88.61) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 0.142 acre of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.
